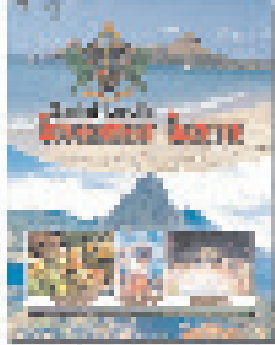
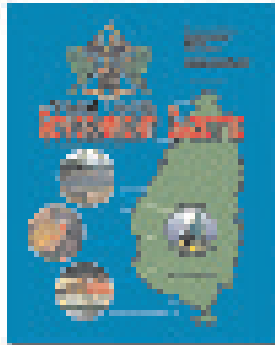
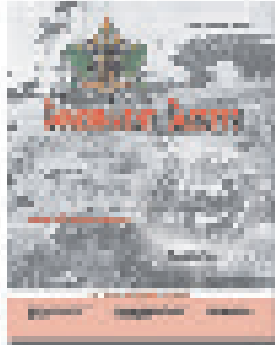

Post of Coordinator for the National Capacity Needs Self-Assessment (NCSA) for Global Environmental Management Project

APPPLICATIONS are invited from suitably qualified persons for appointment to the post of Project Coordinator for the National Capacity Needs Self Assessment (NCSA) for Global Environmental Management, within the Ministry of Physical Development, Environment and Housing.

Background:

The Government of Saint Lucia is a Party to several Multilateral Environmental Agreements (MEAs), including the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity (UNCBD), and the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD), each of which imposes obligations on Government and offers opportunities to secure assistance to address the impacts of these phenomena.

A major constraint to responding effectively to the impacts of these MEAs is the weak national capacity to do so. Against this background the Government of Saint Lucia has received assistance from the Global Environment Facility (GEF) to undertake a National Capacity Needs Self Assessment for Global Environmental Management (NCSA). The project will be implemented by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and executed by the Ministry of Physical Development, Environment and Housing.

Classification:

This is a project management post for a fixed period of two years and does not fall within the public service classification.

Relationships and responsibilities:

The successful candidate will:

Work under the direction of, and report to, the Chief Sustainable Development and Environment Officer; and

Be required to respond whenever necessary to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Physical Development, Environment and Housing and the Project Steering Committee (PSC), on matters related to work in progress.

Duties and Tasks:

Coordinate the work of all stakeholders under the guidance of the PSC and the (NEA) in consultation with the GEF implementing agency;

agency and the PSC quarterly progress and financial reports;

Ensure that the outputs of the project address the capacity development needs to enable Saint Lucia to address Climate Change, Biological Diversity protection and/or loss and Land Degradation;

Perform other such duties as may be assigned from time to time by the Chief Sustainable Development and Environment Officer, PSC or Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Physical Development, Environment and Housing in relation to the project.
