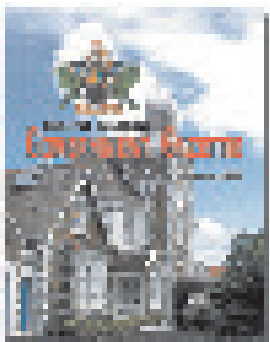
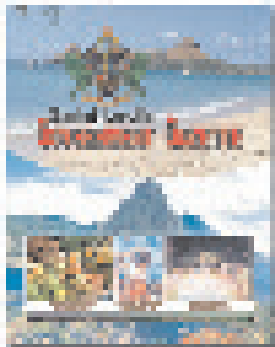
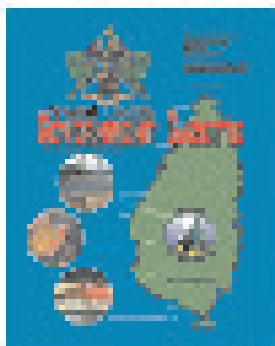

A good degree in Economics or related field (upper second class honors/ equivalent or higher.
