- (j) Monitor adherence by the Organisation to the Treaty of Basseterre and the revised CARICOM Treaty;
- (k) Assist the Secretariat to give effect to decisions of the Authority in pursuance of the objectives of the Treaty of Basseterre
- (l) Monitor and ensure the efficient administration of legal projects undertaken by the Organisation; and
- (m) Carry out such other duties as may be required from time to time.

Qualifications and Experience:

The ideal candidate will be a dynamic individual with a proactive approach who is able to function effectively in a multidisciplinary environment. The successful candidate should also meet the following criteria:






