**UPGRADED ECCB BANKNOTES**

IN accordance with Article 19 (3) of the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank Agreement 1983, the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank gives notice of the upgrade of two security features in the ECCB family of banknotes, in its on-going effort to combat counterfeiting. Upgrades have been made to the security thread and the filigred foil, which are as follows:

**Security Threads**

The security thread in the upgraded notes fluoresces under UV light, and the letters ECCB as well as the value of the note are visible in yellow, against a blue background on the front of the note. When viewed from the back, the thread appears yellow-green in colour. A second security thread has also been added.

**Intaglio Over Filigree Foil**

The notes carry a highly reflective silver filigree foil on which the value of the note is evident. The letters ECCB, as well as the denomination are visible in fine print around the foil, which having been over-printed with intaglio, a special banknote process, has a unique "raised" feel.

All other security features remain the same.

The upgraded notes are being introduced into ECCB member countries on a phased basis, as and when stocks of the existing notes are depleted. The current notes continue to be legal tender and will be replaced in the normal way, through wear and tear.







**S**T. LUCIA will chair the 12th Meeting of the OECS Technical Advisory Committee from July 13th -14th, 2004, at the Royal St. Lucian Resort and Spa. That meeting will precede the 8th Meeting of the Environmental Policy Committee of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS) Ministers for the Environment, which takes place here from July 15th to the 16th. Over 30 delegates from the region and Puerto-Rico are expected to attend, including representatives of donor agencies, such as the World Bank, CIDA, and the European Union.

The Environmental Policy Committee meeting is to examine some of the critical emerging environmental issues in the sub region, especially as they relate to trade and the Caribbean Single Market and Economy. The meeting will also look at the greater importance that environment has to play in national development.

Another significant feature of this meeting will be the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Ministers for the Environment of the OECS and the Province of Nova Scotia in Canada.

According to Christopher Corbin, Sustainable Environment Officer, Ministry of Physical Development, Environment and Housing, this MOU seeks to strengthen ties in the area of environmental management, promote business exchanges, and foster closer ties with Nova Scotia, Canada, which is one of St. Lucia's traditional sources of technical support.

"Really what we are hoping to get out of this meeting, especially at the Ministerial level is some clear policy direction as to where the sub-region is going to focus limited resources in the area of environmental management, and to be able to strategically position ourselves so that we can more effectively benefit from the liberalization that is taking place in the economic arena," said Mr. Corbin. The St. Lucia meeting will be used as a platform for the upcoming Mauritius Conference scheduled for January 2005, and a later meeting of the Ministers of the Environment for Latin America and the Caribbean.



## Delegation of CARICOM Foreign Ministers set for Haiti this week

**T**HE Secretariat of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) wishes to inform that, in accordance with the decision taken by CARICOM heads of Government at their recent conference in Grenada "to create a channel of engagement with the interim administration of Haiti", a delegation of CARICOM foreign ministers will be visiting Haiti 13-14 July 2004.

Composed of Foreign Ministers of Antigua and Barbuda, The Bahamas, Barbados, Guyana, and Trinidad and Tobago, the CARICOM Ministerial Team to Haiti will discuss recent developments with the Haitian officials. The Team will report to the Bureau of Conference on its return.

The CARICOM Secretariat wishes to take advantage of the opportunity to dispel misleading information in some sections of the regional media to the effect that CARICOM has called for the release from detention of former Prime Minister Yvon Neptune as one of the conditions for recognition of the Interim Administration as well as for a date certain for elections. CARICOM is fully aware of Haiti's internal workings with regard to due process and to the setting of dates for elections. However, CARICOM does continue to share concerns with other members of the international community with regard to the political, economic, and security situation in Haiti.

## Opposition Leader Lauds Government's Initiative

**O**PPPOSITION Leader and Parliamentary Representative for Dennery North, Honourable Marcus Nicholas has lauded the efforts of the Government and in particular, the Ministry of Social Transformation for undertaking to renovate a community centre in his constituency, at a cost of \$200,000. The communities of Gros Islet will also have a fully refurbish and renovated community centre, at the same cost.

At a signing ceremony in the Ministry for Social Transformation on Friday June 9th, 2004, Mr. Nicholas said that the availability of such a facility in Dennery North would augur well for the youth, stressing that it would serve as a deterrent for those who may be tempted to engage in unsociable activities. He added that developments like these also make a very positive impact, particularly on parents and children.

"You have a lot of young children going in there; the mothers come around; it is around an area where you have lot of young people gathering. So, it is definitely going to have an impact on the persons and they too, will appreciate it," Mr. Nicholas said.

Minister for Social Transformation, Culture and Local Government, Honourable Menissa Rambally, stated that her Ministry was on an ongoing crusade to develop the proper environment, and create meaningful ways for effective community development.

"So today, I want to indicate that the Ministry's objective is simply to put infrastructure down in communities and constituencies; our objectives are not just to ensure that we have every where we go around, fancy and lovely building. Yes, we like to know that we are seeing those physical advancements. But more importantly, our mandate is to see after the social aspects of the development of our communities," Minister Rambally said.

Renovation and Refurbishment of the Gros Islet Community Centre will be undertaken by Hebert Construction, while Denco Construction will execute works on the La Ressource centre.

The projects, which are to commence soon will be supervised by the consultant engineering firm of Goodridge and Associates.
