## PROCUREMENT OF SCHOOL FURNITURE SL/WB-ICB-G-03/05

THIS revised Invitation for Bids follows the original General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in the United Nations Development Business (UNDB) issue no. 596 of December 16, 2002; and the updated notice that appeared in dgMarket and UNDB online on March 13, 2005.

The Government of St. Lucia has received a loan (hereinafter called the "loan") from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (hereinafter called the Bank) and a credit from the International Development Association toward the cost of the St. Lucia OECS Education Development Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan and credit to payments under the contracts for the procurement of school furniture, divided into 5 lots, for four existing and two new secondary schools. Bidding is open to all eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits.

The Government of St. Lucia, herein represented by the Ministry of Education, Human Resource Development, Youth and Sports, now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the supply of school furniture for four existing and two new secondary schools.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement Under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries

as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. There will be two (2) delivery phases. During the first delivery phase, shipment is required within twenty-five to twenty-seven weeks from contract signature. During the second delivery phase, shipment is required within forty-three to forty-five weeks from contract signature.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and may inspect the Bidding Document at the address shown below (\*) from 9:00 A.M. - 12:30 P.M. and 1:30 P.M. - 4:30 PM on normal business days.
