## Vacancy Notices

### Consultancy for the Review and Development of Services for Young Offenders

*Terms of Reference*

**Rationale:**

The Ministry of Home Affairs and Internal Security in St. Lucia is seeking the services of a Consultant to formulate a 3 year Strategic Plan (2006-2009) to inform the development of a standardized, multi faceted rehabilitation programme for Young Offenders (males and females). Young Offenders include: (i) Male and Females from age 12 to 16 (juveniles) (ii) youth from age 16 to 21. These young people are placed at the following agencies under the jurisdiction of the Ministry namely:

**(1) Probation and Parole Department**

**(2) Boys' Training Centre (BTC)**

The current environment for Juvenile Services with respect to the rehabilitation of both boys and girls dictates that at this time, a thorough and comprehensive analysis of existing services, Human Resource Competencies, Job Functions, Organizational Structure and operational deficiencies be carried out so as to ensure that the Ministry has the institutional capacity to effect a proactive response as it seeks to address the upsurge in youth violence and crime. The above agencies are reporting a trend of more multi-problem adolescents who are presenting a range of more difficult behaviours.

Technical assistance is therefore required to review and assess the current situation with respect to young offenders in St. Lucia and make recommendations on the most appropriate way forward for their rehabilitation at a time of serious financial constraints. Consideration should be given to the specific socio-economic characteristics of Saint Lucia.

The above must also be compatible with the emerging trends in accordance with:

The OECS initiative for a merger of Corrections and Probation and Parole;

Support services for Non Custodial Sentencing;

Best Practices in Institutions for young offenders;

which will impact on the way forward.

**Scope of Work:**

In carrying out the assignment, special attention should be given, but not limited to the following:

Conduct a situational analysis of the institutions/ agencies involved in providing services to young offenders.

Review existing data and conduct a needs assessment for young offenders in Saint Lucia.

Based on the findings of 1 and 2 above:

Identify the resource gaps

Make recommendations on the type and size of facility and/or the institutional arrangements specific to –

A Young Offenders Rehabilitation Centre;

The merger of Corrections and Probation and Parole/LSIR Model;

Non Custodial sentencing.

That should be established, and to indicate the goals, purpose and objectives.

Make recommendations for Programme Development.

Design an appropriate Organizational Structure.

Examine alternative Sentences that maybe available or at least potentially available for non custodial care arrangements.

Design of a Management Information System (MIS) to set up an appropriate Client Data Base.

Review the regime in dealing with young offenders as part of the administration of Justice and to make recommendations.

Develop a model for the successful integration of young offenders into the community upon release.

Advise on the issues that should be addressed in such an undertaking and advise on possibilities with respect to Best Practices.

Outline policy and legislative issues that would need to be addressed.

**Deliverables:**

An outcome measurement process is to be built into this project with identified targets and time frames, as well as a provision for written reports on the progress and findings of the consultancy at periodic meetings with the Ministry of Home Affairs and Internal Security.

**Experience:**

Proven experience in similar or related exercises would be an asset.

**Project Cost:**

The cost of Services for the Consultancy

is to be clearly stated and itemised.

It is expected that the work will be started not later than January 2006, and be completed by April 2006.

As you may be aware, the Society of Honour known as the Order of Saint Lucia was established as from 13th December, 1986.

The grades are as follows:

The Grand Cross.

The Saint Lucia Cross.

The Medal of Honour in classes of Gold and Silver.

The Medal of Merit in classes of Gold and Silver.

The Les Pitons Medal in classes of Gold, Silver, and Bronze.

The National Service Cross.

The National Service Medal.

**Grand Cross:** The Grand Cross is for award only to a person appointed to the office of the Governor-General.

**National Service Cross:** Nominations for an award of the National Service Cross can only be made by the Chairman, Public Service Commission as this award is intended for Gazetted Officers of a certain rank in the Royal Saint Lucia Police Force, the Saint Lucia Fire Service and the Saint Lucia Prison Service.

**National Service Medal:** Nominations for the National Service Medal can only be made by the officers in charge of the Royal Saint Lucia Police Force, the Saint Lucia Fire Service and the Saint Lucia Prison Service.

The general public should therefore be concerned with nominations for the following four (4) grades:

The Saint Lucia Cross;

The Medal of Honour;

The Medal of Merit; and

The Les Pitons Medal.

**Saint Lucia Cross:** The Saint Lucia Cross is to be awarded to persons who have rendered distinguished and outstanding service of national importance to this country.

**Medal Of Honour (Slmh):** The Medal of Honour is to be awarded in any two (2) classes (Gold or Silver) to persons rendering eminent service of national importance or performing an outstanding brave or humane act to a national of Saint Lucia or of

another country.

**Medal Of Merit (Slmm):** The Medal of Merit is to be awarded in any two (2) classes (Gold or Silver) to persons contributing long and meritorious service in the Arts, Science, Literature and other such fields.

**The Les Pitons Medal (Slpm):** The Les Pitons Medal is to be awarded in any of three (3) classes (Gold, Silver, or Bronze) for long and meritorious service to Saint Lucia, tending to promote loyal public service, national welfare or inculcating and strengthening community spirit.
