Some of these are articulated within the recently developed national water policy, the Agricultural policy and strategic plan, the coastal zone management policy, and the national land policy which is in the final stages of development. THE Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court (ECSC) pursuant to a mandated from the Governments of its Member States through the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States (OECs Authority) has secured a Technical Assistance Grant from the Canadian Cooperation Fund (CCF) established by the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) to assist in financing consultancy services for the development of the appropriate legislative framework that would strengthen the judicial branch of government of Eastern Caribbean.

The overall objective of the Consultancy is to formulate and prepare legislation that will: promote greater accountability of the magistracy within the judicial and administrative chain of command; restructure the Judiciary in the Eastern Caribbean with magistrates being integrated fully into the Judicial branch; and, eventually achieve a strengthened judicial branch of government by promoting an efficient, fair, impartial and independent Justice system.

There are two distinct though inter-related phases in the consultancy. Phase I involves the development of a strategic policy approach for the restructuring of the judiciary. The policy report as a result of phase I will serve as a guide and instructions for phase II. Phase II involves the drafting of model legislative documents that would lead to the implementation of the policies developed in phase I.

The ECSC now invites an eligible consultant or a team of consultants to submit statements of capability to provide the required services for Phase I and /or Phase II. In the assessment of submissions, consideration will be given to the technical competence, qualifications and experience, local and regional experience on similar assignments, financial capability and present commitments. All information shall be submitted in the English language.

Two copies of the submissions must be delivered to the address mentioned below no later than 17:00 hours on Friday 29th December 2006. The sealed envelopes containing the submission should include the name

and address of the applicant and should be clearly marked "STATEMENT OF CAPABILITY: CONSULTING SERVICES -INTEGRATION OF THE MAGISTRACY".

Following assessment of the submissions, a shortlist of not less than three and not more than six applicants will be provided with full terms of reference and invited to submit technical and financial proposals to undertake the assignment. The ECSC reserves the right to accept or reject late applicants or to cancel the present invitation partially or in its entirety. It will not be bound to assign any reason for not short-listing any applicant and will not defray any costs incurred by any applicant in the preparation and submission of statements.
