# TECHNOLOGY - COMPUTER VIRUS

## Replication strategies

In order to replicate itself, a virus must be permitted to execute code and write to memory. For this reason, many viruses attach themselves to executable files that may be part of legitimate programs. If a user tries to start an infected program, the virus' code may be executed first. Viruses can be divided into two types, on the basis of their behavior when they are executed. Nonresident viruses immediately search for other hosts that can be infected, infect these targets, and finally transfer control to the application program they infected. Resident viruses do not search for hosts when they are started. Instead, a resident virus loads itself into memory on execution and transfers control to the host program. The virus stays active in the background and infects new hosts when those files are accessed by other programs or the operating system itself.

## Nonresident viruses

Nonresident viruses can be thought of as consisting of a finder module and a replication module. The finder module is responsible for finding new files to infect. For each new executable file the finder module encounters, it calls the replication module to infect that file.

## Resident viruses

Resident viruses contain a replication module that is similar to the one that is employed by nonresident viruses. However, this module is not called by a finder module. Instead, the virus loads the replication module into memory when it is executed and ensures that this module is executed each time the operating system is called to perform a certain operation. For example, the replication module can be called each time the operating system executes

a file. In this case, the virus infects every suitable program that is executed on the computer.

Resident viruses are sometimes subdivided into a category of fast infectors and a category of slow infectors. Fast infectors are designed to infect as many files as possible. For instance, a fast infector can infect every potential host file that is accessed. This poses a special problem to anti-virus software, since a virus scanner will access every potential host file on a computer when it performs a system-wide scan. If the virus scanner fails to notice that such a virus is present in memory, the virus can "piggy-back" on the virus scanner and in this way infect all files that are scanned. Fast infectors rely on their fast infection rate to spread. The disadvantage of this method is that infecting many files may make detection more likely, because the virus may slow down a computer or perform many suspicious actions that can be noticed by anti-virus software. Slow infectors, on the other hand, are designed to infect hosts infrequently. For instance, some slow infectors only infect files when they are copied. Slow infectors are designed to avoid detection by limiting their actions: they are less likely to slow down a computer noticeably, and will at most infrequently trigger anti-virus software that detects suspicious behavior by programs. The slow infector approach does not seem very successful, however.

## Inhospitable vectors

It is difficult, but not impossible, for viruses to tag along in source files, seeing that computer languages are built for human eyes and experienced operators. With the notable exception of WMF, it is almost impossible for viruses to tag along in data files like MP3s, MPEGs, OGGs, JPEGs, GIFs, PNGs, MNGs, PDFs, and DVI files (this is not an exhaustive list of generally trusted file types). Even

if a virus were to 'infect' such a file, it would be inoperative since there would be no way for the viral code to be executed. A caveat must be mentioned from PDFs, that like HTML, may link to malicious code. Further, an exploitable buffer overflow in a program which reads the data files could be used to trigger the execution of code hidden within the data file, but this attack is substantially mitigated in computer architectures with an execute disable bit.

It is worth noting that some virus authors have written an .EXE extension on the end of .PNG (for example), hoping that users would stop at the trusted file type without noticing that the computer would start with the final type of file. (Many operating systems hide the extensions of known file types by default, so for example a filename ending in ".png.exe" would be shown ending in ".png".) See Trojan horse (computing).

## Methods to avoid detection

In order to avoid detection by users, some viruses employ different kinds of deception. Some old viruses, especially on the MS-DOS platform, make sure that the "last modified" date of a host file stays the same when the file is infected by the virus. This approach does not fool anti-virus software, however, especially that which maintains and dates Cyclic Redundancy Codes on file changes.

Some viruses can infect files without increasing their sizes or damaging the files. They accomplish this by overwriting unused areas of executable files. These are called cavity viruses. For example the CIH virus, or Chernobyl Virus, infects Portable Executable files. Because those files had many empty gaps, the virus, which was 1 KB in length, did not add to the size of the file.

Some viruses try to avoid detection by killing the tasks associated with antivirus software before it can detect them.



## ECSE

### Eastern Caribbean

Another slow week was recorded on the ECSE as there were no changes in the market prices of any listed securities. Shares of St Kitts Nevis and Anguilla National Bank traded

firm at \$3.30.

The next auction of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 91 day T Bill will take place on Thursday January 3, 2008. More information on these and other issues can be obtained at the ECSE's website, or by contacting a broker dealer.

### Trinidad:

Trading on the TTSE was significantly affected by the short work week, as both volumes and values traded, took a hit with the latter falling by over TT\$45 million. Grace Kennedy Limited emerged volume leader holding firm on its last traded price of TT\$6.20 and representing 43% of traded volumes. Coming in second was another cross listed security, Sagicor Financial Corporation, accounting for a respectable 10% of total activity despite closing down some 14 cents.

As the year comes to an end, there appears to be no end in site for the battle over Barbados Shipping and Trading Company (BS&T). In

the latest news, NEAL and Massy Holdings, has commenced legal action to have a court order removed. ANSA McAL filed an injunction against Neal and Massy from taking up 56.6% of the shares of BS&T last week.

### Jamaica:

In news from Jamaica, both the JSE Market Index and the All Jamaica Composite advanced while the JSE Select Index declined by 0.14%. Of the 32 stocks traded 18 advanced, 8 declined and 6 traded firm. Total market volume exceeded 55 million units valued at over \$386 million. Gleaner Company was the volume leader with over 61% of total activity followed by Cable and Wireless Jamaica Ltd. and Desnoes & Geddes Ltd.

International Rating Agency, Standard & Poor's has affirmed a double-B credit rating for National Commercial Bank Jamaica Limited. The rating agency highlighted that the financial institution has maintained its stable outlook but explained the rating, was constrained by the sovereign rating on Jamaica, because sovereign bonds and loans to public entities represent most of the Bank's assets.

### Barbados:

In Barbados both the local and composite indices advanced as the Regular Market traded a total volume topping 3 million shares. The top

three traded companies were Cable & Wireless Barbados Limited accounting for over 50% of total weekly volume followed by Banks Holdings Limited and Fortress Caribbean Property Fund.

In other news, Barbados National Bank has recorded \$5 million more net after-tax profit than in 2006 as it continues to cement its stake in the island's financial services sector. The bank, which copped the prestigious Bank of the Year award for the third consecutive year recorded a \$53 million net profit after tax while its assets stood at \$2.4 billion by the end of the 2007 financial year, a \$232 million increase on last year.

### International:

Internationally, U.S. stocks tumbled after government reports on durable goods and unemployment reinforced speculation the housing-market collapse will push the economy into recession.

In currencies news the dollar posted its biggest weekly drop against the Euro since April 2006, and fell against all except one of the 16 most-actively traded currencies as a slumping housing market and upheaval in Pakistan made U.S. financial assets less attractive to international investors.

And finally, crude oil prices gained 2.9% last week and have risen 59% from a year ago.

# SPORTS

## CRICKET



Fidel Edwards starred in West Indies' first Test win in South Africa

West Indies won their first Test since May 2005 and their first ever in South Africa with a landmark 128-run victory in Port Elizabeth on Sunday.

The Proteas dismissed the tourists for 175 early on day four, but their batsmen never looked like making 389.

Jacques Kallis (85) and AB de Villiers (60) resisted, but the rest crumbled.

Fidel Edwards (3-37) and Jerome Taylor (3-66) shone as the Windies beat a top nation away for the first time since beating England at Edgbaston in 2000.

After that Birmingham win, they had endured an away record of four wins - all against Zimbabwe and Bangladesh - eight draws and 32 defeats.

And their overall record in South Africa had been eight losses and one draw.

## West Indies in historic Test win

"Everyone played a part in this win," said captain Chris Gayle, who was leading the team in a Test for the first time.

"It's unbelievable, especially since we are just getting to know our new coach John Dyson. But we are really going to enjoy this victory.

"It's not the series, but it's a win and it feels really good. Beating South Africa in four days on [their] home soil is tremendous - it's my best match so far."

The visitors added 29 to their overnight 146-8, in which time Daren Powell edged a Harris

delivery into his stumps and Taylor was caught at long-on after striking 22 from just 28 balls.

The Proteas were quickly in trouble at the start of their second innings when Herschelle Gibbs fell fo.

Powell winning an lbw appeal as the batsman offered no shot to ball angling in from outside off-stump.

Smith said the visitors deserved their momentous triumph, adding: "We let ourselves down in the first innings with the ball and with the bat.

"We allowed them to get to a first-innings total that was always going to make it difficult for us to come back from, and then we didn't bat well.

"We didn't get our basics right, and we didn't adapt to the pitch well enough which seems to be a theme with us here."

South Africa - ranked second in the world before the Port Elizabeth Test - look set to ring the changes.

Gibbs's place will come under scrutiny and the experienced Shaun Pollock may return for the two remaining Tests in early January.
