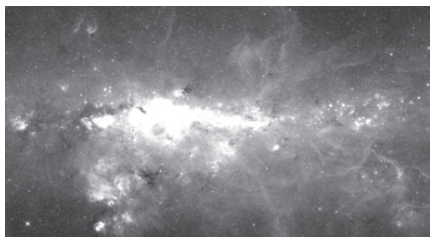

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Our Galaxy's Best and Brightest



The Peony nebula star was found in the crowded, dusty center of our Milky Way galaxy, seen here in a false-color infrared view from NASA's Spitzer Space Telescope.

Scientists using NASA's Spitzer Space Telescope have uncovered a star that could be a contender for our galaxy's brightest light - and they say there might be even brighter bulbs out there, shrouded in cosmic dust.

The Peony nebula star, heralded today in an image advisory from the Spitzer team, doesn't look all that bright to the naked eye. Sirius is still the undisputed local champion, based on what we can see in the night sky. But a big factor behind Sirius' apparent brightness is its relative proximity to Earth - a mere 8.7 light-years, or roughly 50 trillion miles.

If you were to put all the stars observed in the heavens on an equal footing distance-wise, the gold medal for brightness would go to Eta Carinae, which is more than 7,500 light-years away but is thought to shine 4.7 million times brighter than our sun.

Now consider the star recently spotted by Spitzer: It's a whopping 26,093 light-years away, in the Milky Way's crowded center. The Peony nebula star (so named because it's wrapped in a flowery-looking nebula) is so shrouded in dust that you might not be able to tell just how bright it shines even if you were up closer.

Spitzer's infrared camera was able to pierce the clouds of dust and get a better fix on the star's luminosity. Infrared readings from the European Southern Observatory in Chile were also factored into researchers' calculations.

"Infrared astronomy opens extraordinary views into the environment of the central region of our galaxy," Potsdam University astronomer Lidia Oskinova explained in today's advisory. Oskinova is the principal investigator behind the research as well as the second author of a paper about the star, due for publication in the journal *Astronomy and Astrophysics*.

Oskinova and her colleagues estimate that the Peony nebula star shines 3.2 million times as brightly as the sun. That would merit a silver medal, based on current standings. And because there is some uncertainty built into the luminosity estimates for the Peony as well as for Eta Carinae, it's conceivable that the two stars are roughly equal in brightness.

Astronomers estimate that the star started out with a mass 150 to 200 times that of our

sun. That would be around the theoretical limit for the mass of stars. If you go much heavier, the star would break up into a multiple-star system during formation, astronomers say.

The Peony nebula star is classified as a Wolf-Rayet star, with a diameter roughly 100 times that of our sun. If it were placed where our sun is, its outer layers would extend to about the orbit of Mercury, the Spitzer team said. Such stars shed an enormous amount of material over a relatively short lifetime of a few million years. Winds of stellar radiation drive this material outward at speeds of up to 1 million mph.

Like Eta Carinae, the Peony nebula star appears to be on the very brink of going supernova. That's the way it is with superstars: The brightest lights often burn out the fastest.

"When this star blows up, it will evaporate any planets orbiting stars in the vicinity," Oskinova said. "Farther out from the star, the explosion could actually trigger the birth of new stars."

And that's another thing about being the best and the brightest: There's always someone waiting in the wings who may be even better and brighter. "There are probably other stars just as bright, if not brighter, in our galaxy that remain hidden from view," Oskinova said



ECSE

Eastern Caribbean

Equity trading was limited last week on the ECSE as fewer than 1000 shares traded. Shares of SKNB traded up 17 cents while ECFH traded down 50 cents to close at 14.50.

In the bond market, the Government of St Lucia successfully auctioned \$30 million dollars of 6.8%, 5 year Treasury Notes on July 9th; and on July 11th, the Government of Antigua issued EC\$17 million of 91 day Treasury Bills at a rate of 6.5%. On July 16th, the Government of Grenada will auction EC\$35 million of 1 year Treasury Bills.

In other news, Grenada Electricity Services (GRENLEC) will on July 16th list on the ECSE with the trading symbol GESL.

Trinidad:

In Trinidad, the advance decline ratio was 11 to 9. Winners included Ready Mix Ltd which was up 4.38, Ansa Merchant Bank- up 4.52 and Angostura Holdings- up 1.06. Sagicor, Guardian Holdings, First Caribbean lost for the week.

Jamaica:

All three Jamaican indices ended the week in positive territory. Advancers included Grace Kennedy and Scotia DBG Investments while Pan Jamaica Investments and Jamaica Producers Group closed on the downside.

Barbados:

On the Barbados stock exchange, Grace Kennedy, One Caribbean Media & Fortress led trading volumes over the review period. Market indices posted mixed results as 4 stocks advanced and 2 declined.

Barbadian Prime Minister David Thompson delivered his first budget

presentation last week labeling it as one of restraint., framing the island's economic outlook for 2008-2009 within the context of a lethargic global economy. Based on current estimates, Barbados' economic growth is expected to peak at 2.5% in 2009, limited by an inflation rate that is set to reach 7.9% by year-end, while public debt is to rise to almost 8% of the Gross Domestic Product.

International:

On the international front, U.S. stocks fell for a sixth week, sending the S & P 500 Index into a bear market as fuel prices climbed to records.

And finally, in currencies and commodities,. The dollar dropped to within a cent of the all-time low against the euro. Gold rose to the highest since March as record energy costs and slumping equities spurred demand for the metal as a hedge. Silver also gained.

Jayawardene predicts close contest

Mahela Jayawardene, the Sri Lanka captain, has predicted a close contest in the three-Test series against India, while his counterpart Anil Kumble emphasised his team's consistency in the run-up to the tour, during a press conference in Colombo to launch the series.

"Every time we've played them, there has been some really good cricket played by both teams, who possess some good-quality players," Jayawardene said. "I am sure that the public will have a great series to watch."

"We thoroughly enjoy playing India, at home or away," he said "It's always been a tough challenge. There is good rivalry with our neighbours."

Jayawardene said his team's focus was on winning the series and not on stopping Sachin Tendulkar from getting the 172 runs needed to overtake Brian Lara, who has 11,957 runs to his name, as the highest run-scorer. "I don't think

we will try that hard not to give him the record. We are going to treat Sachin in the same manner as anybody else in the Indian camp," he said. "It will be a great milestone if he achieves it, but our focus will be on the series.

He also spoke about his performances against India. "Personally I have a couple of milestones against India. I made my debut against them and also scored my first double-hundred against them. It's a pretty good team for me to play against."

Kumble was upbeat about India's prospects considering the players at his disposal and the team's recent record. "The last time we played Sri Lanka in India we beat them. We are confident," he said. "We have Zaheer Khan back in the team with his experience of bowling in subcontinental conditions, Ishant Sharma who has really progressed well as a seamer, and Harbhajan Singh is back as well."

"We have a good combination and we have done pretty well in the lead up to the Test series," he said. "In the last one year or so we have been really consistent with our performances. That's something which we will take forward."

Kumble, who has not played in Sri Lanka since the 1993-94 tour, said the senior members of the team had experience of the conditions there. "The conditions would be pretty similar [to those in India] and the players we have in the team are all quite used to these conditions, especially the batting line-up. They are familiar with what to expect."

He also expected his team's middle order to cope with the threat posed by Ajantha Mendis, who destroyed India in the Asia Cup earlier this month with figures of 6 for 13. "We have the quality [to counter Mendis] ... our middle order has more than 30,000 Test runs and four of them have played more than 100 Tests," he said. "It will be challenging and I am sure our batsmen will definitely cope with that. It is something obviously we need to be on the look out for."

Meanwhile, former captain Hashan Tillakaratne has been appointed as the Sri Lankan team's manager. He replaces Shriyan Samararatne.

India play a three-day warm-up match against a Sri Lanka Board XI from July 18 to prepare for the first Test, which begins on July 23.

FOOTBALL

Drogba to decide Chelsea future

Didier Drogba's agent claims he will sign a new Chelsea contract if the striker does not find another club in the next 10 days.

Drogba, 30, has been linked with Barcelona, AC Milan and a move that would re-unite him with former Chelsea boss Jose Mourinho at Inter Milan.

But his agent Thierno Seydi says he may stay and sign a long-term Chelsea deal.

He said: "Didier has given himself 10 days. If nothing happens he'll stay and extend his contract by two years."

Seydi added: "He doesn't see himself starting training in a few days with Chelsea and then leaving to a new club.

"The reality of November is not that of today. At the time Didier was affected by departure of Jose Mourinho who he was very close to. Today, there is nothing to say that he won't stay at Chelsea."

Drogba has seemed destined for the Stamford Bridge exit door for months but recently looked to be reconsidering his options.

New Chelsea boss Luiz Felipe Scolari claimed at his official unveiling that Drogba was still "200% in his plans"

Marseille president Pape Diouf, meanwhile, claims to be "amused" by an appeal launched by his club's fans to raise the 44 million US dollars they believe necessary to buy Drogba.

The fans have launched an audacious bid to bring the striker back to the club he left four years ago.

Despite suffering a setback when their website crashed, the new appeal reached 1.5 million US dollars on Sunday.

The fans behind the initiative admitted that it would be impossible to raise the money to buy Drogba, instead insisting that the point of the project was to alert Diouf to the fans' wishes.

"I'm surprised and amused. It shows the true passion of our supporters," Diouf told regional newspaper La Provence.

However, he joked that even if the fans could raise the money for the transfer, that alone would not be enough.

He added: "I know what Drogba earns at Chelsea!"
