# Windows worm trickery for Vista

The Conficker virus has opened a new can of worms for security experts.

Drives such as USB sticks infected with the virus trick users into installing the worm, according to researchers.

The "Autoplay" function in Vista and early versions of Windows 7 automatically searches for programs on removable drives.

However, the virus hijacks this process, masquerading as a folder to be opened. When clicked, the worm installs itself.

It then attempts to contact one of a number of web servers, from which it could download another program that could take control of the infected computer.

Bad guys

The worm is unusually clever in the way that it determines what server to contact, according to F-Secure's chief research officer Mikko Hypponen.

"It uses a complicated algorithm which changes daily and is based on timestamps from public websites such as Google.com and Baidu.com," said Mr Hypponen in a blog post.

"This makes it impossible and/or impractical for us good

guys to shut them all down – most of them are never registered in the first place.

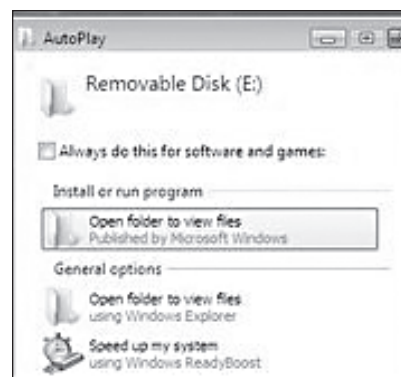
"However, the bad guys only need to predetermine one possible domain for tomorrow, register it, and set up a website – and they then gain access to all of the infected machines," he added.

It has also emerged that the virus automatically disables the automatic updates to Windows that would prevent further infection.

As the virus - also known as Downadup - has spread to an estimated 9m computers globally, a number of high-profile instances of the virus have arisen.

The Ministry of Defence has been battling an outbreak of the virus across its network for more than two weeks, and on Tuesday a network of hospitals across Sheffield told technology website The Register that more than 800 of their computers had been infected.

Users are urged to download the KB958644 Security Update from Microsoft to mitigate the risk of infection.

ECSE

### EASTERN CARIBBEAN

Seven stocks traded on the ECSE last week, with 3 stocks trading firm, two advancing and two declining. The volume leader was Dominica Electricity Services, which traded down over 33% to close the week at \$2.00. The two advancers were ECFH and TDC, up 13 cents and 15 cents, respectively.

### TRINIDAD:

Volumes traded on the TTSE totaled over 1.4 million units with a total value of TT\$37.3 million. Neal & Massy emerged volume leader for the period. The advance decline ratio was 3 to 4 with Sagicor leading the advancers closing up \$1 while Ansa Merchant Bank led the decliners.

### JAMAICA:

All three JSE indices posted advances, with 13 of the 34 stocks traded last week closing up. 9 stocks declined while 12 traded firm as total volume of shares traded exceeded 5.8 Million units valued at over J\$48 Million. Scotia Group Jamaica was the volume leader followed

by Mayberry Investments and Gleaner Company Ltd.

### BARBADOS :

Barbadian indices were down last week as the Regular Market traded a total volume topping 29,000 shares. The top three traded companies were Sagicor, Goddard Enterprises and Neal & Massy Holdings Limited. The sole share to record a price movement was Neal & Massy, which traded down 5 cents to close at \$15.80.

In others news, recent economic developments have forced the Central Bank of Barbados to drop interest rates on deposits from four per cent to three per cent effective February 1st.

### INTERNATIONAL:

Internationally, U.S stocks fell for a second week, led by financial companies, after Citigroup Inc. announced that it will split in two and Bank of America required emergency federal funds for its acquisition of Merrill Lynch.

In currencies, news, the euro dropped against the dollar for a third week in its longest losing stretch since November as the European Central Bank cut borrowing costs by a half- percentage point and signaled it may lower interest rates again.

## TENNIS

### Federer and Djokovic ease

Roger Federer cruised into the third round of the Australian Open with a 6-2 6-3 6-1 win over Evgeny Korolev.

The second seed will next face 2005 champion Marat Safin, who enjoyed a 7-5 6-2 6-2 win over Spain's Guillermo Garcia-Lopez.

Novak Djokovic progressed to the last 32 with a 7-5 6-1 6-3 win over Frenchman Jeremy Chardy.

Tenth seed David Nalbandian suffered a shock 6-4 5-7 4-6 6-4 6-2 defeat to Chinese Taipei's Lu Yen-hsun.

"Maybe tonight I won't be able to sleep," said Lu.

"This is the first time I've beaten a top 10 player, and it's in a Grand Slam."

There were no such problems for 11th seed David Ferrer of Spain who beat Slovakian Dominic Hrbaty 6-2 6-2 6-1 to set up a tie with Marin Cilic.

The Croatian was in impressive form as he saw off Serbian Janko Tipsarevic 6-2 6-3 4-6 6-3 in front of a boisterous crowd on Court Two.

Federer found Russian qualifier Korolev, who defeated former world number one Carlos Moya to set up the tie, no match for him.

The first set took just 28 minutes as Federer got two early breaks, the second went with serve until the eighth game when Federer got the breakthrough, and he broke the Russian twice early in the third to race to a 4-0 lead.

Korolev held to make it 4-1 but, with the youngster's

unforced error count mounting, Federer closed out the match with ease in one hour and 27 minutes.

"I'm happy the way it went. He was also a good opponent to play against and there were a lot of good shots," said Federer, before looking ahead to the Safin clash.

"I'm happy to play Marat, we've had some great matches over the years.

"I think it's going to be a great match already in the third round, which is a pity in some ways, but I hope we can come up with some good tennis."

Djokovic, 21, was made to work in a tight first set, which he took at the death when it looked to be heading for a tie-break.

But Chardy, ranked 68 in the world, proved unable to tame the Serbian for long, and Djokovic took full control of sets two and three to turn the match into a procession.

## ATHLECTIC GB Olympians line up in Glasgow

Britain's team for the International Match in Glasgow next week contains 12 athletes who competed at the Olympics.

After their four medals in Beijing, the likes of heptathlete Kelly Sotherton and sprinter Craig Pickering will be keen to start the indoor season well.

The GB team will face the United States, Sweden, Germany and a Commonwealth Select squad at Kelvin Hall on 31 January.

There is no place for Dwain Chambers because of his previous drugs ban.

Chambers, silver medallist in the 60m at the World Indoors last year, cannot compete at the indoor event as it falls under the umbrella of a Euro Meetings Group event.

The consortium passed a ruling last year which prevents athletes who have served a two-year drugs ban from taking part in its competitions, thereby ruling out the 30-year-old after his positive test for steroids in 2003.

UK Athletics has though confirmed Chambers' eligibility for the European Indoor Championships in Turin in March, where he will be favourite to win the 60m title.

Britain's 17-strong team includes 32-year-old Sotherton whose first heptathlon in Gotzis, Austria is not until May.

Injury hampered her Olympics build-up and after just missing out on a medal she told BBC Sport last week: "I just feel renewed and the disappointment at the Olympics hasn't eaten at me. It's still there but that is what is driving me."

Sotherton will compete in the women's long jump and 60m hurdles in Glasgow, while Pickering, who failed to progress beyond the 100m second qualifying round in Beijing, runs in the 60m.
