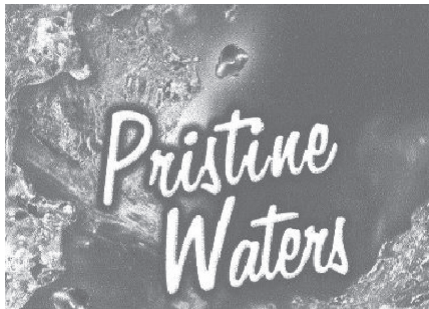

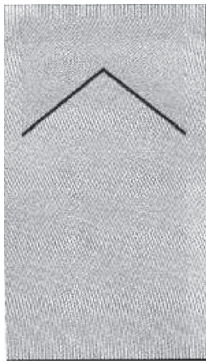

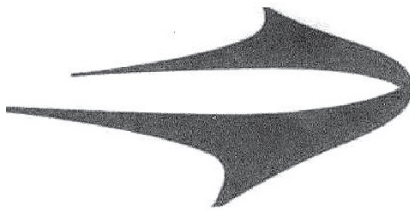

## Secure Your Vista PC with Easy Steps - Part 1

While Windows Vista may be Microsoft's most secure operating system ever, it's far from completely secure. In its fresh-from-the-box configuration, Vista still leaves a chance for your personal data to leak out to the Web through Windows Firewall, or for some nefarious bot to tweak your browser settings without your knowing. But by making a few judicious changes using the security tools within Windows Vista--and in some cases by adding a few pieces of free software--you can lock down your operating system like a pro.

### Use Windows Security Center as a Starting Point

For a quick overview of your security settings, the Windows Security Center is where you'll find the status of your system firewall, auto update, malware protection, and other security settings. Click Start, Control Panel, Security Center, or you can simply click the shield icon in the task tray. If you see any red or yellow, you are not fully protected. For example, if you have not yet installed an antivirus product on your machine, or if your current antivirus

product is out-of-date, the Malware section of the Security Center should be yellow. Windows does not offer a built-in antivirus utility, so you'll want to install your own. For free antivirus, I recommend AVG Anti-Virus 8.

### Use Windows Defender as a Diagnostic Tool

The Malware section also covers antispyware protection, and for that Windows Vista includes Windows Defender. The antispyware protection in your antivirus program usually trumps the protection Microsoft provides, but there are several good reasons to keep Windows Defender enabled. One is that every antispyware program uses a different definition of what is and what is not spyware, so redundant protection can actually offer some benefit.

Another reason to keep Windows Defender enabled: diagnostics. Click Tools, and choose Software Explorer from the resulting pane. You can display lists of applications from several categories such as Currently Running Programs, Network Connected Programs, and Winsock Service Providers, but Startup Programs is perhaps the most useful. Click on any name in the left window, and full details will appear in the right pane. By highlighting, you can remove, disable, or enable any of the programs listed.

### EASTERN CARIBBEAN

It was a short trading week for the regional stock exchanges.

The only share to trade on the Eastern Caribbean Stock Exchange was St.Kitts Nevis Anguilla National Bank which traded 88 shares at \$2.99.

In other news, the next auction of Government of St. Vincent Treasury Bills will take place on January 9th, 2009.

### TRINIDAD:

On the TTSE over 600,000 shares valued at over 15 Million dollars changed ownership. NCB Jamaica emerged volume leader closing down 5 cents for the week at 80 cents. Scotia Bank also declined, falling \$1.50. Sagicor and Trinidad Cement were the only winners, increasing by 25 cents and 1 cent, respectively.

Adverse global and regional economic conditions affected the 2008 profitability of First Caribbean International Bank Limited (FCIB). For the financial year ended October 31, 2008, FCIB reported an EPS of US\$0.11, a 31.6 percent deterioration over the 2007 EPS of US\$0.16. A final dividend of US\$0.03 per share has been approved, bringing the total dividend for the year to US\$0.06.

### JAMAICA:

In Jamaica, the markets saw mixed results as the Market

Index was down while the JSE Select and the Composite indices closed on the upside. Cable & Wireless which traded up 1 cent, was the volume leader, followed by Supreme Ventures - up 30 cents and Mayberry Investments - down 18 cents.

### BARBADOS:

Barbadian indices closed in negative territory for yet another week as the Regular Market traded a total volume topping 34,000 shares. The top three traded companies were Sagicor followed by Light & Power Holdings and Cable & Wireless.

Microfinance lending institutions in Latin American and the Caribbean stand to benefit from a pioneering fund, the Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF) which has been set up by the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to assist countries in dealing with the effects of the global credit crisis and other emergencies.

### INTERNATIONAL:

The S&P 500 fell 1.7 percent during the holiday-shortened week, extending its 2008 slide to 41 percent as home prices plunged, the government confirmed the economy contracted by the most since 2001 last quarter and the outlook for corporate earnings deteriorated.

The yen posted its first weekly decline against the dollar in two months as Japan's inflation slowed and industrial production slumped

## Cricket

### SA secure series win in Australia

South Africa won a first Test series in Australia with a nine-wicket triumph at the MCG, becoming the first team in 16 years to beat the Aussies on home soil.

Resuming on 30-0 in search of 183, they needed 42 more overs, Graeme Smith firing 10 fours in a commanding 75.

Neil McKenzie made an unbeaten 59 and Hashim Amla (30) hit the winning runs.

A South Africa win in the final Test at Sydney starting on Saturday would make them the world's top-ranked side and seal Australia's first home whitewash.

Australian cricket's iconic Melbourne ground was full of empty seats on the final day of the second Test, but there was a sprinkling of South Africans in attendance to see their team take an unassailable 2-0 lead in the series 15 overs into the afternoon session.

Inspirational skipper Smith, who became South Africa's youngest captain at the age of 22 in 2003, looked set to be there at the finish, but after recording his 24th Test fifty he succumbed to a quicker ball from spinner Nathan Hauritz.

There was a hint of rain in the air when play resumed after lunch, with the Proteas requiring just 51 further runs for victory, but it did not materialise.

McKenzie had struggled for form earlier in the series with 12 runs in three previous innings and was bowled off a no-ball when on just two by Brett Lee late on day four.

But he stepped down the pitch to launch Hauritz back over his head for six, and having surviving some confident lbw appeals from Lee and Mitchell Johnson, he recorded his 16th Test fifty.

There was a stroke of good fortune about the boundary off Johnson that did it, however, Matthew Hayden fumbling a difficult low chance to his right at first slip.

By that stage only 31 were needed in any case, and less than 10 overs later it was all over, Amla clipping slow left-armer Michael Clarke through mid-wicket for two.

An emotional Smith praised his team's collective effort, but gave special mention to JP Duminy, who scored a magnificent 166 in the first innings to put South Africa into a commanding position on the third day.

"Everyone has contributed and made it count," he enthused. "Who could have said we would have batted so well at eight, nine and ten the other day, and JP's knock was an incredible achievement for such a young guy to be so composed and play the way he has.

"The belief though the team is really flowing.

"It's important to say Australia are still a quality unit and it's a real honour for us to come here and beat them. To be 2-0 up after two games is something we only dreamt of."

Fast bowler Dale Steyn, who took 10 wickets in the game and scored 76 in the first innings, was named Man of the Match.

The 25-year-old has taken 74 Test wickets this year said: "It's happened so quickly, the team has done fantastically, led by a fantastic captain."

Stalwart wicketkeeper Mark Boucher said: "We have had a lot of heartbreak in this part of the world and to even think about winning a series in Australia was always going to be tough but I believe this team will go from strength to strength now." All-rounder Jacques Kallis was delighted to finally win in Australia on his fourth tour. "It's an unbelievable feeling," he said. "We knew to beat Australia here you need a bit of luck to go your way and play the big moments well.

"For the senior players we realised how tough a task it was and this rates with winning a World Cup, if not better. South African cricket is healthy and hopefully we can keep the side together and stay on top for a while."

The baggy greens had not lost at home since 1992-93, when they were defeated by the West Indies.

They had seemed in a commanding position during the opening match of the current series, in Perth, before a remarkable fight-back by South Africa saw the visitors chase down an unlikely second-inning target of 414.

Smith's side came from behind equally strongly at the MCG, where they ended the second day at 198-7 - nearly 200 runs behind their hosts.

But a ninth-wicket partnership of 180 between Duminy and Steyn helped turn the game around, and Steyn's five-wicket haul in the second innings reduced Australia to 247, leaving the tourists a modest victory target.
