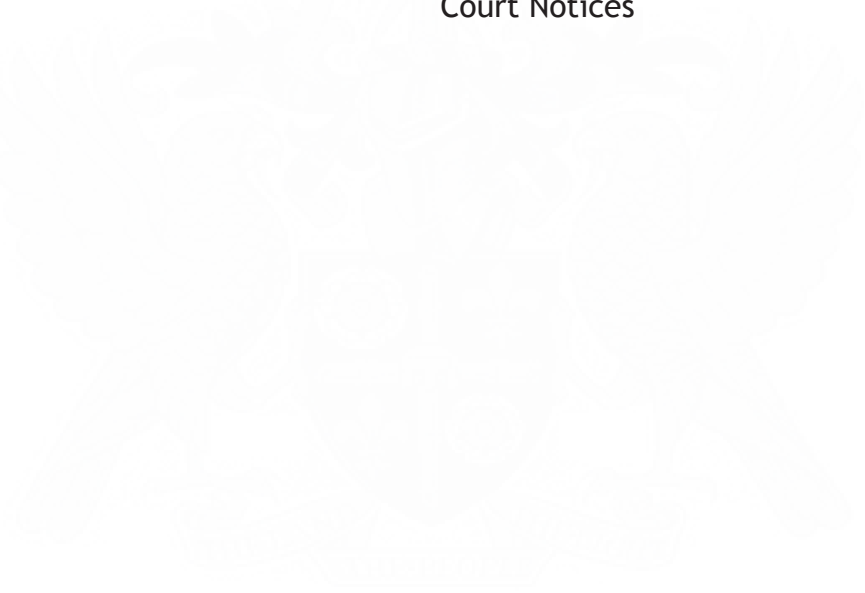

Key Duties:

Supervise staff and direct the work of the Legal and Legislative Drafting Units;

Provide support to the work of the OECS Competition Commission; and

Carry out such other duties that may be required or assigned from time to time by the Director General.
