Ability to, and experience in collaborating actively with the United Nations Secretary-General, with heads and senior staff of UN system agencies, funds and programmes as well as of other international entities, the private sector, and civil society organizations;

Excellent communication and representational skills;

Highest possible standards of integrity in professional and personal matters.

In order to ensure a sufficiently diverse pool of candidates for the position of Executive Secretary of the UNFCCC, the Secretary-General would supplement any nominations received from member states with additional inputs and consultations.

On the basis of nominations received, the Secretary-General will identify a shortlist of candidates from which he will, on the basis of a rigorous interview procedure, select the candidate that best meets the criteria indicated above. 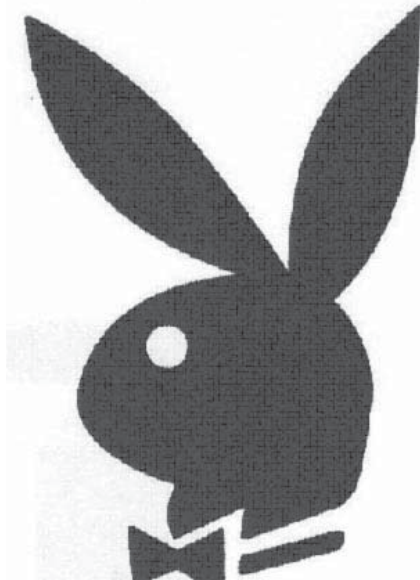

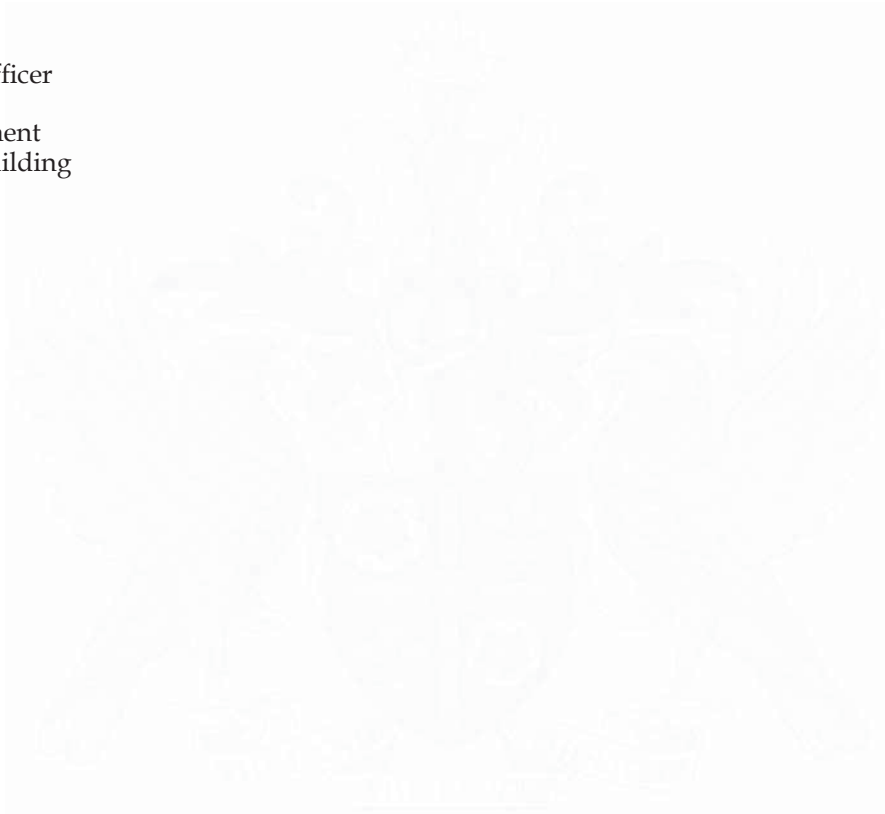

EASTERN CARIBBEAN

Trading activity picked up on the ECSM as approximately 154000 shares valued at almost EC\$650,000 crossed the floor of the exchange. This resulted from trading in 7 equity securities, of which 4 traded firm and 3 decline. Bank of Nevis and St. Kitts Nevis Anguilla National Bank emerged volume leaders accounting for 65% of trading activity.

In other news, two Treasury bill issues were successfully auctioned on the RGSM. The Government of St. Lucia successfully raised EC\$16 million via a 91-day 5.25% Treasury bill issue and the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines also raised EC\$20 million via a 91-day 5.50% Treasury bill issue.

Regional investors have one more week to take advantage of the 8-year fixed rate bond being auctioned by the Government of St. Lucia on March 25th & 26th. This bond issue offers an attractive rate of 7.5%. The minimum bid for this instrument is EC\$5,000.

TRINIDAD

Mixed results was recorded on the TTSE as the Composite and Cross Listed indices advanced while the All-TT index declined slightly. Overall market activity resulted from over 2.4 million shares valued at almost TT\$6.4million changing ownership. This resulted from trading in 19 stocks of which 4 advanced 6 declined, while 9 traded firm. JMMB was the lead advancer, also managing to emerge volume leader with over 2 million shares crossing the floor of the exchange.

JAMAICA

Over in Jamaica, the major three indices posted gains as 37 equity securities recorded trading activity. Market

volume exceeded 34 million units valued at over J\$596 million. Advancers outnumbered decliners 16 to 12, while another 9 stocks traded firm. Scotia Group Jamaica and followed by Sagicor Life Jamaica were the most popular stocks traded. Ciboney Group recorded the largest price movement declined by almost 17%.

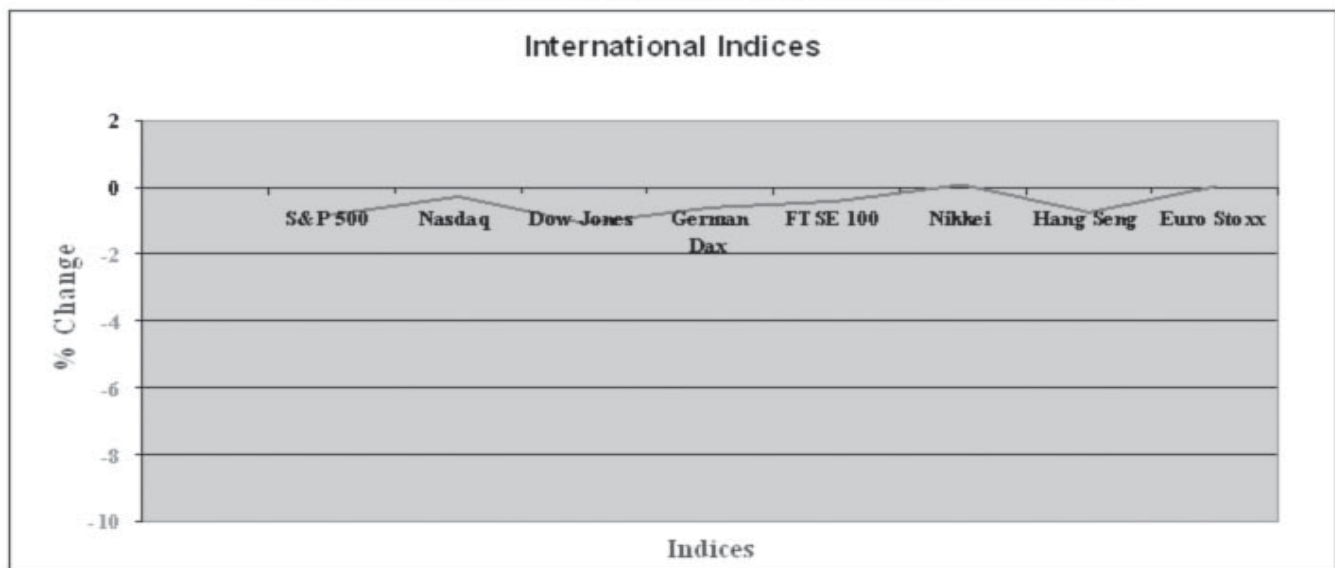
BARBADOS

Moderate activity was recorded on the BSE as almost 85000 shares traded. This resulted from trading in 7 securities; of which 3 advanced, 2 declined and another 2 remained unchanged causing all three indices to close in negative territory. Fortress Caribbean and Sagicor Financial Corporation were the most popular stocks traded.

INTERNATIONAL

On the international front, in currencies news, the greenback advanced against most of its traded counterparts, reducing investment appeal for commodities as an alternative investment. And the euro continues to weaken on concern that Greece will fail to secure financial assistance from the European Union.

US stocks are expected to rally erasing early slumps as demand for health care shares increase.



Microsoft brings audio, video to its Mac IM

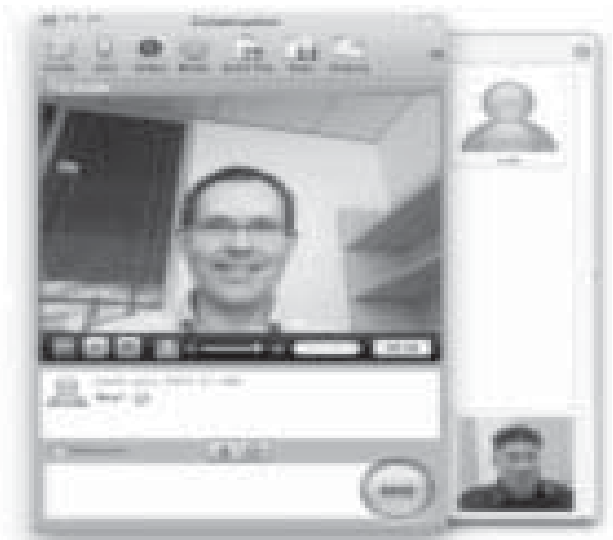
Aiming to bring its Mac instant messaging software closer to par with Windows, Microsoft on Wednesday offered a beta version of Messenger for Mac 8.

The test software brings, at long last, audio and video conferencing features to the Mac. A final version of the product is due out with the release of Office for Mac later this year.

Microsoft has said since 2008 that it was working to bring those capabilities--long a part of Windows Live Messenger--to the Mac. The company had originally hoped to have a beta version with audio/video capabilities by last year.

The last major update to the Mac IM product, Messenger for Mac 7, was released in 2008.

Those who want to try the beta of Messenger for Mac 8, with its audio and video conferencing abilities, can download it from Microsoft's Mac Web site. However, Microsoft lists a couple of known issues with the product including an inability to display profile pictures and problems sending files from one user to another.

Cheaper electric car rides on battery manufacturing



Rather than a technology breakthrough, the route to cheaper electric cars is high-volume manufacturing of lithium ion batteries, according to an electric vehicle expert.

Management consulting company PRTM on Monday released a statement arguing that people are underestimating the projected demand of electric vehicles when it comes to battery capacity.

The companies and countries that can ramp up operations for both battery pack and battery cell fabrication are the ones that will profit as electric cars become cost competitive with gasoline-powered cars in the next six to eight years, said Oliver Hazimeh, the director of PRTM's Global E-Mobility practice.

Increasingly, this is not a localized game. There is a strategic global race going on," said Hazimeh.

China, in particular, is "completely committed to EVs" in part because projected demand for first-time car buyers

will cause a spike in demand for oil, Hazimeh said.

The U.S. federal government last August announced a \$2.4 billion investment in battery manufacturing, which was matched by private companies. That has led some industry watchers to wonder if there's a bubble in electric car components. But PRTM argues that plug-in vehicle volumes will ramp up significantly in 2016 in Europe and 2018 in the U.S. as costs approach gas-only cars.

"The game will be won by quickly ramping up to scale and driving the costs down," Hazimeh said. "Smaller start-ups will have a hard time if they cannot scale up quickly."

Right now, the lithium ion battery manufacturing is dominated by Asian companies, with more from China emerging. Hazimeh said that manufacturing battery cells, rather than battery pack assembly, is more strategic in the long run.

Technology improvements will play a role in bringing the cost of energy storage down, but PRTM projects that will not come into play until 2020. Between now and then, battery costs will go down by about half based on supply chain expansion, with plug-in vehicles representing about 10 percent of new cars sales, the company projects.

In the meantime, high costs for batteries mean that electric vehicles, such as the Nissan Leaf and Chevy Volt, will be aimed mainly at early adopters, who may enjoy the acceleration of electric motors, and fleet operators, which tend to buy based on total cost of ownership rather than purchase price.

SPORTS

CRICKET

West Indies A replace New Zealand A for England tour

West Indies A will replace their New Zealand counterparts as tourists during the English season.

New Zealand Cricket had requested to postpone their A-team tour which was scheduled to include a triangular tournament with India A and England Lions as well as a number of first-class matches and two Test matches against the India side.

West Indies will now step into their place, which will be a boost to the WICB who are looking to increase the overseas exposure of their younger players and those on the fringes of international selection. They will now take part in the one-day tournament and face India in the two Tests.

The West Indies players are required back in the Caribbean in mid July so the original programme has been altered to include the four-day and three-day matches before the triangular series rather than afterwards.

Meanwhile, Sri Lanka Under-19s will now visit in place of Australia Under-19s for a tour in July and August which includes two Tests, two Twenty20s and five one-dayers.

Mirpur mistakes will spur UDRS usage - David Morgan

David Morgan, the ICC president, believes that the umpiring controversies that marred the third day of the Mirpur Test will help to encourage all cricket boards to embrace the use of the Umpire Decision Review System, but added that the business of footing the bill must still be shared by the host broadcaster for each series.

"I think that UDRS makes for wonderful television," Morgan said. "It adds a dimension to the package that a viewer receives, and I do believe that the broadcasters have a responsibility to fund part of it. Cricket is not afloat with dollars and pounds and euros. It is not a rich sport and we believe there has to be a contribution.

"But next time Bangladesh host international cricket, against New Zealand in October, I am sure that the BCB will have the equipment available," he added. "They clearly regret not having it in this series."

Shakib Al Hasan, Bangladesh's captain, was critical of the BCB following the third day's play, saying that had they chosen to pay for the referral technology, his team could have claimed a first-innings lead over England and made a push for their fourth Test victory.

"We would have been in a very good position if [UDRS] was in use here," he said. "I think we would have asked for a referral four times with full confidence, and three of them would have come to our way for sure. It's really bad for us that we did not use the referral system, which we could have done."

"Umpires can make mistakes, but a series of mistakes have gone against us, and it's very unfortunate," said

Mustapha Kamal, the BCB president. "We have been talking about [UDRS] issue, but we found that other countries have not been using it extensively, so we thought that, first of all, we must know about the system itself. It is very delicate and if we misused it, it might go against us."

Speaking during an official visit to Bangladesh ahead of next year's World Cup, Morgan also defended the integrity of the ICC's elite umpires following Andy Flower's pre-series comments that more influential teams tend to get the rub of the green in marginal decisions, a suggestion that was backed up by Bangladesh's coach, Jamie Siddons, at the close of the third day's play.

"I have a great deal of time for Andy Flower. I have not chatted with him on this matter, but I'd like to," said Morgan. "I cannot accept that any of our international or elite umpires are biased. This game will be monitored in Dubai, and the match referee is here monitoring umpire performance as well. We will also listen to the captain of Bangladesh and the coach, but their views will not necessarily be regarded as value judgements at the end of the day.

"The UDRS system is being rolled out and is being used significantly more than in situations such as this when it is not in use," said Morgan. "Boards and broadcasters are being pressed to ensure it is available, and I think it will not be too long before we have the system operating with the optimum equipment available at each Test match, wherever it is played in the world."

Historical Focus

2nd April 1957: Marquis de Castries Portrait

His Lordship the Bishop of Castries, Monsignor Charles Gachet presented a portrait of the Charles Eugene Gabriel de la Croix – Marquis de Castries to Town Council Chairman Maurice M. Mason. The unveiling was done by His Excellency the Prefect of Martinique who visited the island especially for the event.

31st March 1794: Capture of Morne Fortune

General Grey, leaving five regiments under the command of General Prescott for the protection of Martinique attacked and captured Saint Lucia in the Morning of March 31, 1794. The island did not have the means of a formidable defense and on the 4th April, His Royal Highness Prince Edward marched for 14 hours from his landing place and hoisted the British colours on its chief fortress Morne Fortune.

The garrison consisted of 300 men who surrendered on the same terms of capitulations granted to General Rochambeau. Richard the officer commanding, desired and obtained permission as Rochambeau had done, to embark for North America but the garrisons both of Saint Lucia and Martinique were sent to France immediately on their surrender.

After the conquest of Saint Lucia, General Grey appointed Sir Charles Gordon Governor and left two regiments with detachments of artillery and engineers as a garrison, turned his attention to Guadeloupe.
