WHAT IS MY ROLE AS A JUROR IN THE CORONER'S COURT?

As a Juror in the Coroners Court you will sit on a panel with at least four (4) other persons sworn as Jurors and you will listen to the evidence or testimony of witnesses.

You will hear all witnesses then you will meet in private with the other jurors to decide the following questions:

Who was the Deceased?

What age was the Deceased at the time of his/her death?

When did the Deceased die?

Where did the Deceased die?

How and in what manner did the Deceased die?

THE CORONERS COURT

The Magistrate's Court in each District is also the Coroners Court.

The Coroners Court holds Inquests to determine when, where and by what manner the Deceased came to his/her death and whether anyone should be held criminally responsible for that death.

WHAT IS AN INQUEST?

An Inquest is an investigation into a death of a person. The Coroners Inquest is inquisitorial. It aims to establish the facts about events leading to a death. It is a fact finding exercise.

CORONER

The Coroner is a Magistrate who examines all the evidence presented in the court. At the end of the last witness' testimony, the Coroner will give directions to the members of the Jury.

The Coroner is addressed as "Mister/Madame Coroner"

PRESENTER

In some Inquests, a Presenter may be used. The Presenter will assist the Court by presenting evidence to the Court. He/she is addressed as 'Mister/Madame Presenter.'

CLERK OF COURT

He/she assists the Coroner in different ways e.g. by swearing in witnesses and Jurors.

Microsoft launches Internet Explorer 9 beta

Microsoft launched the beta of Internet Explorer 9 on Wednesday, promising to use the whole power of the PC to set Web sites free from the constraints previously imposed on them.

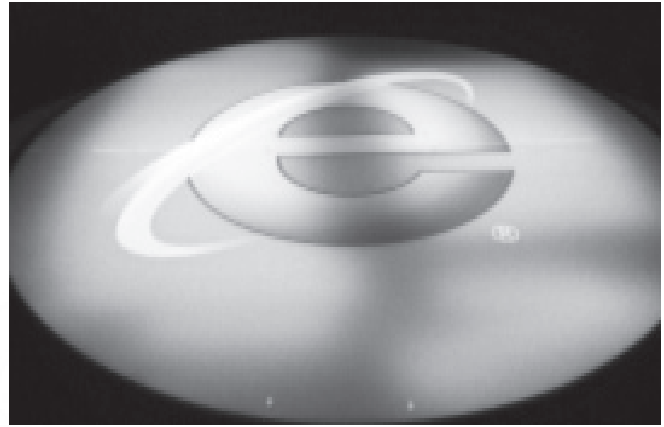
“The Web is about sites,” Corporate Vice President Dean Hachamovitch said at an event here. “Browsers should be too. Today, Web sites are boxed in.”

The new browser features a minimalistic user interface, hardware acceleration, and broader support for Web standards including HTML 5 and CSS 3.

For Microsoft, the arrival of IE9 is an attempt to compete more fully with Mozilla’s Firefox, Google’s Chrome, and other browsers. Although various flavors of Internet Explorer are still used for one in three Web site visits, Microsoft has been losing share for years as rivals have moved ahead technically.

With IE9, Microsoft is trying to change that, while also bringing more of Windows 7’s capabilities to the browser. The new browser allows users to pin a Web site to the Windows 7 taskbar, much as a user can do already with applications. Sites that are pinned in this fashion can then program “jumplists” that allow surfers to quickly move through various parts of the Web site.

Other features include the ability to monitor which add-ons are slowing down the browser as it launches as well as a download manager that warns users if the code they are grabbing has a bad reputation and is potentially malicious.

Much of Wednesday’s launch is set to focus on various partners that have built sites optimized for the new browser. The first on stage was Microsoft’s own Bing search engine, which showed both its jumplists as well as a new HTML 5-powered home page that allows Bing to show either moving pictures or a video on its home page. Microsoft said it plans within a month to offer a spiffed up Bing site in preview form, using some of the HTML5 capabilities of IE9.

The IE9 beta is available starting Wednesday and works with Windows Vista or Windows 7.

Hachamovitch typically sports a new Internet Explorer-themed black shirt at each event where he speaks. For Wednesday’s launch, his shirt says “Beauty,” with the greek letter beta used instead of the B.

WIPA slams Sarwan's contract exclusion

The West Indies Players' Association (WIPA) has "condemned" Ramnaresh Sarwan's exclusion from the WICB's list of contracted players, and has questioned the board's reasoning behind the decision. The WICB said it had cut Sarwan because of concerns about his attitude to fitness. According to a WIPA release, Sarwan's recent injuries had occurred while playing for West Indies and that he had shown initiative in trying to recover quickly, following all directions issued by the board.

According to WIPA, Sarwan had been informed by the WICB chief executive, Ernest Hilaire, of the board's concerns about his attitude

to fitness following a report on West Indies' tour of Australia in November 2009. Neither the players' association nor Sarwan, however, had seen the report. According to the WIPA, in a letter dated January 11, the board said it was not highlighting specific incidents illustrating its concerns about Sarwan but only wanted to sensitize him to the problem.

In its reply to the WICB, the players' association had asked for specific instances when Sarwan did not meet the standards demanded, and wanted the batsman to be given an opportunity to state his case. No reply had so far been received by the WIPA.

The players' association also highlighted that Sarwan's recent injuries had occurred while on West Indies duty - a back problem during the tour of Australia, and a hamstring injury in the home series against South Africa earlier this year. It also outlined the measures Sarwan had taken on his own initiative and expense - undergoing treatment in Florida and Canada - to recover from the injuries. The WIPA also said that there had been no complaints from the team management about Sarwan's attitude or his commitment to training in the past and during the series against Australia and South Africa.

Sarwan, however, had said that he was expecting the setback but that the disappointment would not affect his focus in leading Guyana's ongoing Champions League Twenty20 campaign in South Africa.

Historical Focus

BRIGAND SITES IN ST. LUCIA

After much research, it has become evident that St. Lucia is the only island where there is so much physical evidence of Brigand activity. Apart from Jamaica, where limestone caves of the Cockpit Country provided natural hiding places for the Maroons, only St. Lucia possesses so many defensive structures of the Brigands, such as caves, holes, tunnels and signal stations. This seems to indicate that St. Lucia was of major importance in the Brigand wars of the French Revolution and had strategic value to Victor Hugues in his brilliant campaign in the West Indies. The abundance of such sites may explain why la Croix was able to resist the British for so long in St. Lucia; but more importantly, it may also be the result of a long history of maroonage in St. Lucia.

Canaries may be typical of the Brigand war strategy in the woods of St. Lucia. I believe it was the Brigands' headquarter. A description of this beautiful valley and its Brigand sites should help to explain the elaborate system of defensive posts located all over the hinterland of St. Lucia. Canaries valley is a steep sided watershed catchment for the largest group of mountains in St. Lucia. The valley is extremely narrow, splitting into several equally narrow tributaries, some leading down from the Gimie massif. This valley provided the Brigands with an ideal communication link between the central west coast and the highest interior mountains. Instead of using pathways and trails, the Brigands travelled, whenever possible, through Canaries River and its tributaries, in order to avoid leaving footprints or damaged vegetation, which would be clues for discovery by those in pursuit.

The Brigands constructed a network of strategic posts along the valley designed to provide them with rapid intelligence, safe and swift travel to their secluded camps and the ability to launch surprise attacks from several ambush sites.

An observation post was located on a steep slope, above the northern cliffs of Anse des Canaries, to provide good surveillance of the bay and the sea lanes connecting it to west coast communities. It consisted of a hole leading down into a small underground chamber, quite hidden from the road above and the sea below. On the nearby ridge above, there is an abandoned oven carved into a large rock. A little higher up, on the base of a cliff are two rough-cut caves. In much the same situation to the south of Anse de Canaries are two neatly cut caves, which commanded a good view of Canaries River mouth and sea coast. One was probably used as a temporary depot or Powder Magazine for hiding supplies from Guadeloupe, until the Brigands could move them to their interior camps. The other was an oven.
