Her Excellency the Governor-General will give a brief address followed by a short National Service during which prayers will be said by His Grace Archbishop Robert Rivas, Archdeacon Randolph Evelyn and

the Reverend Madet Merové. The Act of Remembrance will be recited by the Ex-Servicemen League. Her Excellency the Governor General will lay a wreath at the foot of the memorial on behalf of the State.

3. Bidders shall have the following experience and capabilities requirements:

Minimum average annual turnover of EC\$1.0 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last 3 (three) years. In case of Joint Ventures (JV), JV members should jointly meet the requirement, at least one partner must meet at least forty percent (40%) of the requirement, and all other partners must meet at least twenty five percent (25%) of the requirement;
