NOTICE is hereby given that a request was presented to the St. Lucia Registrar of Insurance (the "Registrar") under Sections 131, 132, 133 and 134 of Insurance Act No. 6 of 1995 (St. Lucia) for an Order sanctioning a scheme for the transfer of insurance business (the "Scheme") proposed to be made between the St. Lucia Branch of American Life Insurance Company ("ALICO") and Pan-American Life Insurance Company of the Eastern Caribbean, Ltd. ("Pan-American Eastern Caribbean")

Under the Scheme, ALICO, through its St. Lucia Branch (the "St. Lucia Branch"), intends to enter into a Conveyance and Assumption Agreement with Pan-American Eastern Caribbean (the "Conveyance Agreement"). Pursuant to the Conveyance Agreement, all of the insurance policies issued or entered into by the St. Lucia Branch that are in full force as of the Effective Date (as such capitalized term is defined below) or with respect to which ALICO otherwise has continuing liability, including lapsed insurance policies that are subject to a contractual right of reinstatement (collectively, the "Policies"), will be transferred by the St. Lucia branch to Pan-American Eastern Caribbean and Pan-American Eastern Caribbean will assume the liabilities associated with the Policies (the "Transfer"). It is proposed that the Transfer be completed on a date agreed to by the parties, subject to the satisfaction by the parties of certain closing conditions and the receipt by the parties of all required regulatory approvals, including the approval of the Registrar (the "Effective Date").

The Transfer is part of a larger transaction whereby Pan-American

Life Insurance Group, Inc. ("PALIG") and certain of its affiliates, including Pan-American Eastern Caribbean, will acquire certain subsidiaries, assets and liabilities of ALICO, including the assets of the St. Lucia Branch and the insurance liabilities under the Policies. Once the Scheme is implemented on the Effective Date, Pan-American Eastern Caribbean will be responsible for all liabilities under the Policies. PALIG has advised that there will be no impact on the terms of existing Policies or the strength of the guarantees contained therein. Specifically, PALIG has confirmed that the transaction will not impact the following:

- policy rates, terms and conditions;
- coverage and benefits; and
- service and administration of the Policies.

Pan-American Eastern Caribbean is an insurance company incorporated and licensed under the laws of St. Lucia. PALIG is an insurance holding company incorporated under the laws of the State of Louisiana, U.S.A. It is a direct subsidiary of Pan-American Life Mutual Holding Company. Its affiliated insurance companies offer individual and group life and health insurance products in several jurisdictions in the United States, Latin America and the Caribbean. THE Saint Lucia Development Bank (SLDB) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) towards the cost of Strengthening St. Lucia Development Bank's Due Diligence for Environmental and Social Appraisal of Credit Lines and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of SLDB and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than SLDB shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

SLDB, the Executing Agency, now wishes to procure consultancy services for Strengthening St. Lucia Development Bank's Due Diligence for Environmental and Social Appraisal of Credit Lines.

The objective of the consultancy is to improve the institutional capacity of SLDB to assess and manage environmental and social risks in its project appraisal and supervision processes. The duration of the assignment is expected to be for a period of five (5) months.

SLDB now invites interested eligible individual consultants to submit Expressions of Interest for the provision of these consultancy services.

Consultants shall be eligible to participate if:
