VAT Transitional Procedures**

As you may be aware Value Added Tax will be introduced in Saint Lucia from the 1st October 2012. This introduction will see the termination of the Consumption tax schedule of tax rates. In other words the Consumption Tax rate schedule will be reduced to zero.

Government in an effort at reducing the possibility of double taxation (Consumption Tax and VAT) on goods cleared from Customs and not sold before 30th September 2012, has decided to allow a rent free period from 1st July to 30th September 2012 at the Port Authority Sheds and the Department has approved the duty payment and release of part consignments for registered VAT businesses.

In light of this importers seeking the use of this facility must obtain the necessary VAT Free Storage Certificate Form from the VAT Project Implementation Office. In completing the Customs Declaration special attention should be paid to the following:

In cases of partial clearance of goods, the number of packages (box 6 and 31) declared on the SAD should be less than the number of remaining packages reported on the B/L. This will allow for further partial clearance of consignments on the same B/L.

Brokers need to ensure that the goods being cleared have been properly entered so that proper accounting can be done for B/L consignments. Partial declarations cleared on a B/L will be verified in the write-off segment of the B/L in ASYCUDA World.

If the answer to questions (1) and (2) are both yes, whether for the purposes of an alteration of the Constitution to replace appeals to Her Majesty in Council with appeals to the Caribbean Court of Justice, the Agreement between Saint Lucia and the United Kingdom referenced in section 41(7) (a) –
