**Magistrates Style and Title and  
Dress in Court**

**Introduction**

This Practice Note applies to all the Magistrates Courts in the jurisdiction of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court in which magistrates preside.

**Purpose Of Practice Note**

The purpose of this Practice Note is to change the form of address with the intention to promote uniformity in the jurisdictions in the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court, in the Style and Title of Magistrates and to permit Magistrates to wear robes when presiding in Court and for other official functions.

**Authority**

This Practice Note is made pursuant to the inherent jurisdiction of the Honorable Chief Justice to regulate the style and title and court attire after consultation and the concurrence of the Head of Governments of the OECS Member States and Territories at the 55th meeting of the OECS Authority held on June 11, 2012 in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.

It is hereby directed as follows:

In all Member States and territories of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court, the Style and Title for a Magistrate shall be "YOUR HONOUR".

A Magistrate may wear a robe when presiding in Court and for other official functions.

This practice Note will come into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> day of September, 2012.

SAINT LUCIA has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Hurricane Tomas Emergency Recovery Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") includes two phases: Phase 1- Pre-Construction services and Phase 2- Construction and Post-Construction services and as such the consulting firm shall be responsible for providing technical assistance to the Ministry of Health, Family Affairs, National Mobilization, Human Services and Gender Relations (MOH) in carrying

out field investigations, review of architectural and structural designs, preparation of detailed engineering designs including mechanical and electrical, and technical information including bill of quantities and drawings required for the bidding of the proposed works and providing supervision services and certification of works for the construction of the new Hospital at Dennery. The Consulting Firm will ensure that the hospital is constructed in a manner to mitigate any prospective hazards including storms, hurricanes and floods. To this end, the consulting firm will ensure that the appropriate construction standards are utilized in the preparation of technical documentation required for the preparation of bidding and contract documents aimed at ensuring quality assurance consistent with the acceptable engineering practices based on climate resilient design principles applicable for the region for the proposed construction of the Dennery Hospital at its new site. The consultancy is to be undertaken over a period of sixteen months. The first six months will be for carrying out the pre-construction services which includes the tendering period and the second phase will be for ten months for providing supervision services during the construction of the building. In addition, there will be a defects liability period of one year during which consulting Firm will be requested to participate in the inspection of works along with the Employer's team.

The Ministry of Finance, Economic Affairs, Planning and Social Security now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar

conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).

The minimum required qualifications and experience are:

At least five years experience in design and supervision of civil works contracts

At least one successfully completed contract during the last three years for detailed design and supervision of construction of civil engineering structures such as hospitals, polyclinics with drainage and other complex concrete type structures with a value of at least US\$1.0m

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. The associations should clearly indicate the form of the association (Joint-venture or sub-consultancy; member in charge; other member/s and or sub-consultants). Joint ventures should submit letters of intent indicating their intent to form a joint venture if awarded the contract and shall provide the above mentioned information for each member of the joint venture.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Least Cost Selection method in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers published in May 2004, and revised in October 2006 and May 2010. ("Consultant Guidelines").
