It is hereby directed as follows:

In all Member States and territories of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court, the Style and Title for a Magistrate shall be "YOUR HONOUR".

A Magistrate may wear a robe when presiding in Court and for other official functions.

This practice Note will come into effect on 1st day of September, 2012.
