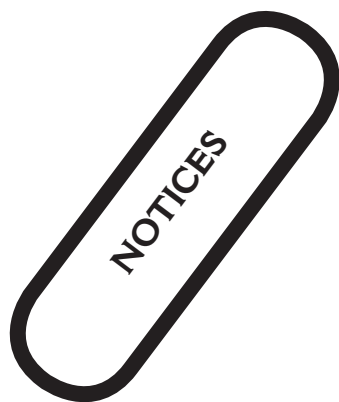

THE Government of Saint Lucia has received financing from

the International Development Association (the World Bank) towards the cost of the Caribbean Regional Communications Infrastructure Programme (CARCIP) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds towards nurturing of local innovation and to develop a more sustainable entrepreneurial base by providing grant funding for ICT/ ICT Enabled interventions/projects submitted by Micro and Small to Medium sized Enterprises (SMEs).

The Government of Saint Lucia herein represented by the Ministry of the Public Service, Information and Broadcasting, now invites eligible local businesses from all economic sectors to apply for financial assistance, Business Incubator Grants, under the ICT -LED Innovation component of the project.

Eligibility

Grants will be made available to registered micro as well as small to medium sized enterprises to support Innovative ICT and ICT enabled strategic business development interventions/projects under the following specific categories:

Technical Assistance: This category will provide financial assistance for short term consultancy services, such as market studies, development of a business plan, feasibility studies and any other specialized technical assistance identified by CARCIP.

Or

Business Development Assistance: This category will facilitate financing of a new business venture, business model service or product that is innovative and technology based and that could increase the sustainability and profitability of the enterprise. These include Investments in equipment, Intellectual or Industrial property protection; and Industry Certification Product and Process upgrades etc. Applications under this component must be supported by a Business Plan.

THE Government of Saint Lucia (GOSL) intends to undertake the full rehabilitation of approximately ten (10) KM of road within Laborie, inclusive of requisite drainage and retaining structures. This project shall be executed utilizing a Design-Finance-Build methodology.

The GOSL intends to apply funds from the Consolidated Fund to cover eligible payments under the Contract for the duration of the payment period. Bidding is open to all interested bidders.

The Government of Saint Lucia herein represented by the Ministry of Infrastructure, Port Services and Transport invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for The South Roads Rehabilitation Project - Banse to La

Haut Road and Laborie Village Main Road.

Bidding will be conducted through standard International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures and is open to all eligible bidders.

Bidders must demonstrate access to, or availability of financial resources such as liquid assets, lines of credits, and other financial means acceptable to the Employer, other than any contractual advance payments, to meet the full financial cost of the project.

The bidder must have experience under contracts in the role of contractor, subcontractor, or management contractor for at least 10 years prior to the application submission deadline. In the case of JV, each partner must meet the aforementioned requirement;

Participation as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least one (1) contract within the last ten (10) years, with a value of at least EC\$15 million that has been successfully and substantially completed and is similar to the proposed works.

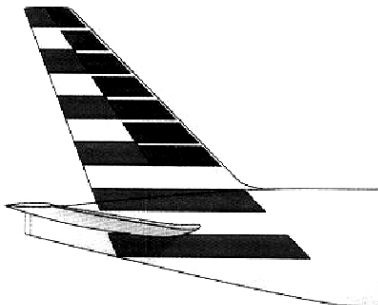

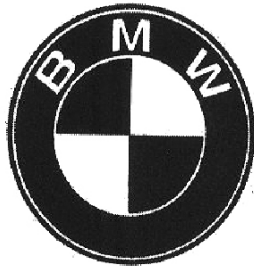

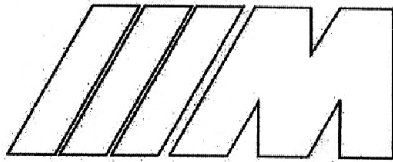
