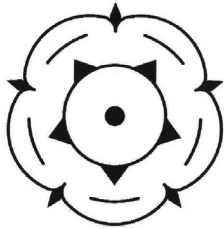

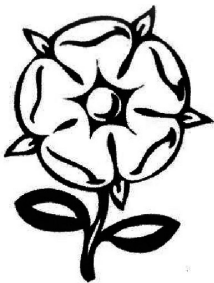

(1) That the matter is adjourned to December 9th 2015 and if no Counsel appears the matter will be struck off for want of prosecution.

(2) That the Claimant is to draw, file and serve this order.
