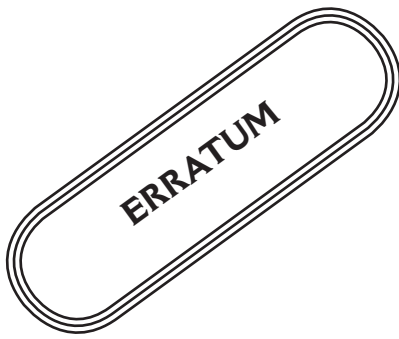

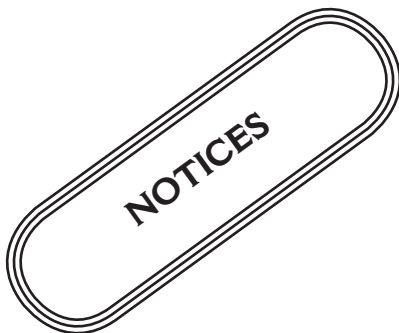

**CLOSURE OF THE LOBSTER FISHERY**

THE Ministry of Agriculture, Food Production, Fisheries, Co-operatives and Rural Development informs the general public that the lobster fishery will be **CLOSED from March 1, 2015, until August 1, 2015**, both days inclusive.

When the lobster fishery is **closed a person shall not:**
