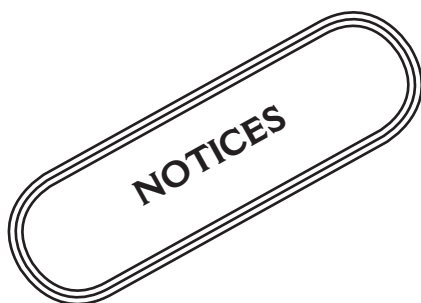

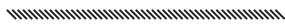

This Declaration of Water-Related Emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to reduce wastage of potable water.

By the issue of this Declaration of Water-Related Emergency, all residents of Saint Lucia are urged to cease the use of potable water for any non-potable uses and from any activity which may cause the contamination of the water.

This Declaration of Water-Related Emergency is effective the 20th day of May, 2015 and remains in effect until 31st July, 2015.

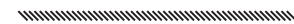
