RELATIONSHIPS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Liaises with the District Guidance Counsellor, Co-ordinator – Guidance Counselling, Chief Education Officer, Permanent Secretary, Deputy Permanent Secretary, Deputy Chief Education Officer – Instruction, Chief Planning Officer, principals, teachers, students, representatives of denominational schools, Sir Arthur Lewis Community College, community groups and organizations, other Government Ministries and Donor Agencies;
2. Works in collaboration with the Co-ordinator – Guidance Counselling and the District Guidance Counsellor to ensure that counselling is administered in a proper and efficient manner.

DUTIES AND TASKS

1. Implement relevant and sustainable guidance and counselling programmes within his/her assigned school. Counsellors will also be responsible for assessing the efficacy of counselling programmes and contributing to the development and implementation of “school-specific” counselling programmes;
2. Provide individual and group counselling to students within his/her assigned school;
3. Initiate and follow-up appropriate student referrals;
4. Demonstrate appropriate case management including the documentation of all counselling interventions and referrals;
5. Seek out and participate in continuing education programmes;

6. Facilitate and oversee support programmes for students and their families (e.g., parent education workshops).

CONDITIONS

1. Accommodation provided in a general administrative office (School);
2. The processes of the Unit will be carried out on the basis of team work. The officer will be expected to be an active team member who understands all the processes of the Unit;
3. The officer will be required to maintain a high level of integrity, confidentiality, honesty and trust at all times;
4. Salary will be paid in accordance with the terms stipulated by the Government in the Estimates of Expenditure or Collective Agreement and is liable to taxation in accordance with the Income Tax Ordinance;
