SEA TURTLE FISHERY CLOSED

The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries, Natural Resources and Co-operatives informs the general public that the **Sea Turtle Fishery** will be **CLOSED** as of **January 01 2019**. All harvesting, sale and consumption of sea turtle meat **must** cease at midnight on December 31, 2018.

The Fisheries Act Cap 7.15 prohibits the harvest, sale, purchase and consumption of sea turtles which includes the whole, any part or its by-products during the closed season. The closed season coincides with peak periods when sea turtles are reproducing and it is established to allow the animals to mature and replenish the population.

Anyone found in possession of a sea turtle, whole or any part, or its by products will be fined a maximum of five thousand dollars (EC\$5000) as stipulated under the Fisheries Act Cap.7.15.

The Department appeals to the general public, fishers and vendors to adhere to the closed season regulations and report to the Praedial Larceny Unit, Marine Police, the nearest Police Station or the Department of Fisheries anyone known to be in possession of sea turtles or its by-products (meat, shell or other parts) during the closed season.


