SEA EGG FISHERY REMAINS CLOSED

THE Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Physical Planning, Natural Resources and Co-operatives informs the general public that the Sea Egg Fishery remains closed.

Recent assessments of the sea egg population conducted revealed very low numbers. This may be due to a number of factors including siltation, unfavourable sea conditions, reduced number of juveniles and illegal harvesting during the closed season. Although persons may be observing a few sea eggs in some locations, harvesting at this time is likely to prevent an increase in the population of the sea eggs to an acceptable level to allow for an open fishery in the future.

When the sea egg fishery is closed no one shall take from the fishery waters, damage, disturb, fish for, sell, expose for sale or have in their possession sea eggs without written permission of the Chief Fisheries Officer. Anyone who fails to comply with any provisions of the Fisheries Regulation, Number 36, shall be liable to a fine of up to Eastern Caribbean five thousand dollars (EC\$5,000.00).

Members of the public are encouraged to report any illegal harvesting or sale of sea eggs to the Marine Police Unit, nearest police station or call the Department of Fisheries at 468-4141/43 or 725-1722.


