## SAINT LUCIA

**No. 28 of 2003**

**AN ACT** to amend the Insurance Act No. 6 of 1995 to provide a time limit for the lodging of an appeal to the High Court and matters connected therewith.

[ 12th January, 2004 ]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

No. 28 ]                      *Insurance (Amendment) Act*                      [ 2003.

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Insurance (Amendment) Act 2003.

**Amendment of section 169**

2. Section 169 of the Insurance Act No. 6 of 1995 is amended by replacing subsection (2) as follows —

“(2) An appeal shall lie from a decision of the Tribunal to a Judge of the High Court within thirty (30) days of the decision.”.
