No. 3 of 2004

AN ACT to amend the Free Zone Act No. 10 of 1999 to make it consistent with the Customs (Control and Management) Act No. 23 of 1990 in determining the value of goods exported out of the Free Zone into the national customs territory.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

No. 3] *Free Zone (Amendment) Act* [2004.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Free Zone (Amendment) Act 2004.

Amendment of section 12

2. Section 12 of the Free Zone Act No. 10 of 1999 is amended by replacing subsection (11) as follows:

“12.— (11) All exports from a Free Zone to the national customs territory shall be subject to duties under the national customs regime, however, such duties shall be based on the customs value in accordance with the provisions of the Second Schedule to the Customs (Control and Management) Act No. 23 of 1990.”
