## SAINT LUCIA

---

### No. 28 of 2005

**AN ACT** to amend the Saint Lucia Mission of Seventh-Day Adventists  
Act 2000, No. 6 of 2000.

[ 21st November, 2005 ]

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by  
and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the  
Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Saint Lucia Mission of Seventh-Day Adventists (Amendment) Act 2005.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Act “principal Act” means the Saint Lucia Mission of Seventh-Day Adventists Act 2000, No. 6 of 2000.

**Substitution of section 4**

3. Section 4 of the principal Act substituted by the following:

**“Officers of Mission**

4.—(1) The Mission shall comprise the following officers:

- (a) a President;
- (b) a Secretary;
- (c) a Treasurer;
- (d) a Trustee Member.

(2) The names and addresses of the officers of the Mission shall be notified from time to time to the Registrar of Companies and registered in his or her office and be subject to the provisions of the Companies Act 1996, No. 19 of 1996.

(3) A person last registered in the manner prescribed in subsection (2) shall be deemed to be an officer authorized to act under the provisions of section 6 of this Act.”.

**Addition of section 4A**

4. The principal Act is amended by adding immediately after section 4 the following —

**“Powers of Mission**

4A. The powers of the Mission shall include the following —

- (a) to employ and remunerate such ministers, officers and other employees and to engage such volunteers as may be necessary;
- (b) to acquire and dispose of property of any description and wherever situated, subject to such consents as may be required by law;

- (c) to borrow money with or without giving security, subject to such consents as may be required by law;
- (d) to raise money by any lawful means and to accept gifts;
- (e) to invest funds in any manner permitted by law, other than by means of loans to individuals, firms or private companies, and for that purpose to obtain and consider professional advice from a person or firm of good repute having the requisite knowledge and experience;
- (f) enter into contracts;
- (g) do other things necessary or convenient to be done in performing the purpose of the Mission.”.
