AN ACT to amend the Revised Edition of the Laws Act 2001, No. 37 of 2001.

[6th February, 2006]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Revised Edition of the Laws (Amendment) Act 2006.

Amendment of section 10

2. Section 10 of the Revised Edition of the Laws Act 2001, No 37 of 2001 is amended by —

- (a) inserting the words "or a part or parts of a revised edition of the laws" between —
 - (i) the words "Laws" and "prepared" appearing in subsection (1); and
 - (ii) the word "edition" and the full-stop at the end of subsection (1);
- (b) inserting the words "of the laws or a part or parts of a revised edition of the laws" between the words "edition" and ", the" in the chapeau of subsection (2);
- (c) inserting the words "or a part or parts of a revised edition of the laws" between the words "Laws" and "specified" appearing in subsection (3);
- (d) deleting the word "complete" appearing in subsection (4);
- (e) inserting the words "or a part or parts of a revised edition of the laws" between the words "Laws" and "shall" appearing in subsection (4);
- (f) inserting the words "or a part or parts of a revised edition of the laws" between the words "Laws" and "shall" appearing in subsection (5);
- (g) deleting the words "first complete" appearing in subsection (7); and
- (h) inserting the words "of the laws or a part or parts of a revised edition of the laws" between the words "edition" and "is" appearing in subsection (7).
