**AN ACT** to amend the Registration, Status and Recognition of Trade  
Unions and Employers Organisations Act 1999, No. 42.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and  
with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of  
Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

and Employers Organisations (Amendment) Act*

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Registration, Status and Recognition of Trade Unions and Employers Organisations (Amendment) Act 2006.

**Amendment of section 25**

2. Section 25 of the Registration, Status and Recognition of Trade Unions and Employers Organisations Act 1999, No. 42 is amended by —

(a) repealing subsection (2) and substituting the following:

“(2) The Labour Commissioner shall, subject to subsection (4), give notice in the prescribed form of an application to the employer to which the application relates.”;

(b) inserting the following as subsection (4):

“(4) The Labour Commissioner shall not in the notice pursuant to subsection (2), submit to an employer information which discloses the identity of any employee in the bargaining unit.”.
