AN ACT to amend the Legal Profession Act 2000, No. 31.

[15th May, 2006]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same as follows:

No. 24] *Legal Profession (Amendment) Act* [2006.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Legal Profession (Amendment) Act 2006.

Interpretation

2. In this Act “principal Act” means the Legal Profession Act 2000, No. 31.

Amendment of section 21

3. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the full stop appearing at the end of subsection (3) and by substituting the following:

“except where the attorney-at-law is acting on behalf of the Government.”.
