AN ACT to amend the Customs (Control and Management) Act, Cap.
15.05.

[12th March, 2007]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

No. 1] *Customs (Control and Management) (Amendment) Act* [2007.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs (Control and Management) (Amendment) Act 2007.

Interpretation

2. In this Act “principal Act” means the Customs (Control and Management) Act, Cap. 15.05.

Amendment of section 23

3. Subsection (2) of section 23 of the principal Act is amended by —

- (a) deleting the number “5,000” and substituting the number “US 100,000”;
- (b) inserting the words “seizure, detention or” before the word “forfeiture” appearing in that subsection;
- (c) inserting a comma and the words “vessels or aircrafts” after the word “goods” appearing in that subsection.

Amendment of section 33

4. Subsection (2) of section 33 of the principal Act is amended by —

- (a) deleting the number “5,000” and substituting the number “US 100,000”;
- (b) inserting the words “seizure, detention or” before the word “forfeiture” appearing in that subsection;
- (c) inserting a comma and the words “vessels or aircrafts” after the word “goods” appearing in that subsection.
