**No. 9 of 2007**

**AN ACT** to repeal the National Crime Commission Act 2003, No. 16.

[ 17th September, 2007 ]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

No. 9 ]        *National Crime Commission (Repeal) Act*        [ 2007.

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the National Crime Commission (Repeal) Act 2007.

**Repeal**

2. The National Crime Commission Act 2003, No. 16 is repealed.

**Winding-up of affairs of Commission**

3.— (1) Within six months of the date of the commencement of this Act the Director of Audit shall —

- (a) arrange for the appointment of independent auditors, to prepare a statement of affairs of the Commission and undertake any other accounting work necessary for the disposal of the assets of the Commission, such work to include, but not to be limited to —
  - (i) an appraisal of the assets of the Commission;
  - (ii) the identification of all liabilities including contingent liabilities and the status of any obligations indicating amounts, types, terms of payment and any other factors relating to obligations;
- (b) meet the cost of the preparation of a statement of affairs and any other work pertaining to distribution of assets from the financial resources of the Commission;
- (c) apply the assets of the Commission to meet the debts and other commitments of the Commission;
- (d) in the event of a surplus of assets over liabilities, utilize such surplus in a project that would benefit crime prevention;
- (e) in the event of a deficiency of assets against liabilities, meet such liabilities in accordance with the Companies Act, Cap. 13.01 in order of the priority of debts;
- (f) take such other action that would facilitate the orderly winding-up of the affairs of the Commission.

(2) Within three weeks of the winding-up of the Commission the Minister shall cause a copy of a report on the dissolution of the Commission to be laid before the House of Assembly and the Senate.
