AN ACT to amend the Public Order Act, Cap. 14.05.

[3rd May, 2011]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Order (Amendment) Act 2011.

Amendment of section 30

2. Section 30 of the Public Order Act is amended –

(a) in subsection (1) –

- (i) by deleting the word “authority” where it appears in that subsection and substitution the words “the written permission of the Commissioner of Police proof of which lies on him or her”;
- (ii) paragraph (a) by deleting the words “as is likely to deceives” where it appears in that paragraph;

(b) in subsection (3) –

- (i) by deleting the word “\$1,000” and substituting the word “\$5,000”;
- (ii) by deleting the words “6 months” and substituting the words “1 year”.
