AN ACT to amend the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap. 15.30.

[19th May, 2014]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Tourism Incentives (Amendment) Act, 2014.

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

“**principal Act**” means the Tourism Incentives Act, Cap.15.30.

Amendment of section 2

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following definitions in their correct alphabetical sequence —

“recreational facilities” includes pools, gymnasiums, gardens, shops, bars, restaurants and any other facilities used for recreational activities within a tourism project which are available for use by guests;

“villa” means —

- (a) a dwelling unit available for rent by guests; or
- (b) a cluster of dwelling units available for rent by guests with supporting recreational facilities;”.

Amendment of section 3

4. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) —

- (a) by deleting the comma immediately after paragraph (k) and by inserting a semi-colon; and
- (b) by inserting immediately after paragraph (k) the following paragraph (l) —

“(l) the construction of a villa.”.
