AN ACT to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act,
Cap.8.01.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by
and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the
Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

No.17] *Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Act* [2015**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Act, 2015.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, “principal Act” means the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Cap.8.01.

Amendment of section 2

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following definition in the correct alphabetical sequence-

“kerb weight” means the unladen mass of a motor vehicle with all necessary operating parts, fluids and equipment while not loaded with passengers or cargo;”.

Amendment of section 17

4. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended, in subsection (3), by deleting the term “gross weight” and by substituting the term “kerb weight”.

Amendment of section 182

5. Section 182 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the term “gross weight” wherever it appears in that section and by substituting the term “kerb weight”.
