**AN ACT** to amend the Saint Lucia Tourism Authority Act, No. 8 of 2017.

[ 2nd July, 2018 ]

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly and the Senate of Saint Lucia, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:

*Saint Lucia Tourism Authority (Amendment) Act*

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Saint Lucia Tourism Authority (Amendment) Act, 2018.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Act, “principal Act” means the Saint Lucia Tourism Authority Act, No. 8 of 2017.

**Amendment of section 7**

3. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended —

(a) in subsection (2) by deleting paragraph (c) and by substituting the following —

“(c) three must be persons nominated by primary —

(i) hotel and tourism associations, and

(ii) trade associations;

for appointment by the Minister in writing.”;

(b) in subsection (3) —

(i) in paragraph (d), by deleting the word “and” appearing immediately after the semi-colon,

(ii) in paragraph (e), by deleting the full stop and by substituting a semicolon, and

(iii) by inserting the following new paragraph (f) —

“(f) trade.”;

(c) in subsection (4), by deleting the words “the primary hotel and tourism associations” and by substituting the words “the relevant association”.

**Insertion of new section 36A**

4. The principal Act is amended by inserting immediately after section 36 the following new section 36A—

*Saint Lucia Tourism Authority (Amendment) Act*

**“Exemption from taxes and duties**

**36A.** Notwithstanding a provision in any law in Saint Lucia, the Authority is exempt from the payment of any taxes and duties.”.
