APPROVED DEVELOPER – UPLIFT INC.**

IN exercise of the power conferred under section 4 of the Special Development Areas Act, Cap. 15.29, the Minister responsible for finance, for a period of five years commencing from the 14th day of September, 2020 and terminating on the 13th day of September, 2025 —
