JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: Special Prosecutor

RELATIONSHIP AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Responsible for the investigation and prosecution of corrupt conduct in accordance with the provisions of Special Prosecutor Act (Act No. 19 of 2022).
2. Provision of professional, efficient and ethical legal services to the Government of Saint Lucia in matters related to a complaint of corrupt conduct by public officers or a public officials, provision of legal advice on investigations with respect to complaints of corrupt conduct, and conduct criminal and civil litigation (including civil recovery) in claims instituted by him/her or referred to him/her by the Director of Public Prosecutions.
3. Submits reports to the Attorney General as required by the Special Prosecutor Act.

DUTIES AND TASKS

1. Receive complaints from the public, conduct investigations and where necessary institute criminal and/or civil proceedings against any public officer or public official for offences related but not limited to corrupt conduct.
2. Manages the day-to-day operations of the Office of the Special Prosecutor ("the OSP") to ensure the provision of the Special Prosecutor Act.
3. Supervises the work of the staff within the OSP to ensure that the Special Prosecutor Act is enforced in an efficient and effective manner.
4. Appears and represents in criminal and civil matters related to corrupt conduct before the Magistrate's Court, High Court and Court of Appeal and proceedings ancillary thereto.

5. Assigns legal staff to represent the OSP in criminal and civil matters related to corrupt conduct before the Magistrate's Court, High Court and Court of Appeal.
6. Reviews, vets and approves documents to be filed by legal staff in criminal and civil matters related to corrupt conduct before the Magistrate's Court, High Court and Court of Appeal.
7. Enters into written agreements with the approval of the Attorney General with consultants required to assist in investigations and/or represent the OSP in criminal and civil matters related to corrupt conduct before the Magistrate's Court, High Court and Court of Appeal.
8. Prepares and vets all legal documents to be filed in criminal and civil matters related but not limited to corrupt conduct before the Magistrate's Court, High Court and Court of Appeal.
9. Functions as the principal representative of the OSP locally, regionally and internationally and in all matters involving corrupt conduct.
10. Liaises with the Director of Public Prosecutions on matters related to corrupt conduct referred to him by the Crown Prosecutions Service.
11. If required, renders assistance from the Commissioner of Police, the Royal Saint Lucia Police Force and Financial Intelligence Authority in the investigation of any matter related to corrupt conduct.
12. Prepares and deliver to the Attorney General within three (3) months after each financial year a report of the work of the OSP during the financial year and makes recommendations on matters relating to OSP to the Attorney General if necessary.
13. Prepares the budget and work plan of the OSP in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Management) Act.
14. Performs such other duties as may be required with respect to the day-to-day operation of the OSP.

POST OF PROBATION OFFICER I

RELATIONSHIPS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To undertake casework of probation matters; conduct pre-sentence investigations and criminogenic risks and needs assessments; prepare presentence reports and monitors activities of assigned probationers, to ensure adherence to probation orders and foster an environment that promotes client reclamation.

1. Prepares pre-sentence reports by conducting pre-sentence investigations, interviewing defendants, consulting with community residents and other stakeholders and maintaining case files, to submit information that supports decision making for sentencing defendants before the Criminal Court.
2. Assists in the identification of criminogenic risks and needs of offenders, by conducting criminal history and other background checks that permit the assessment of offender behavior and determine classification of offenders, to make recommendations for treatment programmes and foster public safety.
3. Develops and implements case management plans in accordance with probation orders and special conditions, utilising educational/vocational, rehabilitation and other pro-social orientation programmes or opportunities, to promote the reclamation of offenders and reduce recidivism.
4. Monitors the activities of assigned probationers in accordance with established monitoring and evaluation frameworks and procedures and/or utilising case management techniques and practices and supervision plans, to ensure adherence to probation orders.

**POST OF MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN II
RELATIONSHIPS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. 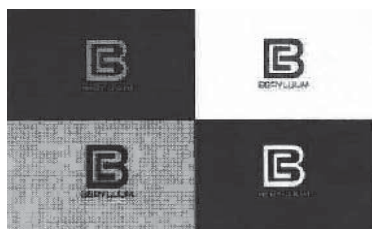
