The regional project is co-executed by the Secretariat of the Cartagena Convention and the German agency Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GmbH) on behalf of UNEP and the IDB, respectively, along with the Organisation of American States (OAS). The Government of Saint Lucia will be implementing the Saint Lucia components in keeping with the Project Cooperation Agreement with UNEP.

The project is geared at promoting IWWM solutions based on the four R's of the circular economy approach: reduce, reuse, recycle, and recover. This would help to reduce wastewater based pollution in watersheds and the marine/coastal space, in keeping with the LBS protocol

3 OBJECTIVES

4 METHODOLOGY

The consultant will work in conjunction with the Water Resources Management Agency (WRMA) and shall perform the tasks listed below in the scope of services required. The Consultant is expected to execute one sub-component of the updated National Package of Activities for the CReW+ Project earmarked for Saint Lucia. This sub-component is titled, "Support for the development of guidelines for onsite and small scale wastewater systems".

The Consultant is expected to engage in relevant stakeholder consultations and collaborate with local

counterparts where necessary, as a means of effectively executing project activities. The Consultant shall report to the WRMA which serves as the GEF-CReW+ focal point for this initiative.

- 4.1 Stakeholder engagement must be done when necessary with project beneficiaries and key counterparts.
- 4.2 The consultant's work will be guided by the GEF CReW+ Updated Situational Analysis Report and National Package of Activities for Saint Lucia.

5 INITIAL PLANNING

The Consultant will be expected to develop a work plan of activities for guiding the progress of the deliverables under this sub-component.

6 SCOPE OF WORK

The Consultant will be required to work in close consultation with the WRMA within the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food Security and Rural Development.

- 6.1 Submit an Inception Report within two weeks of contract signature which describes:
 - i. The procedure, arrangements and methodologies to be used to develop national wastewater guidelines as specified in the updated GEF CReW+ National Package of Activities for Saint Lucia:
 - ii. The work plan containing a schedule of meetings, workshops, consultations and other key activities as per GEF CReW+ National Package of Activities for Saint Lucia
- 6.2 Develop guidelines for on-site and small wastewater facilities, and greywater management for all sectors such as hotels, small communities and restaurants: The Guidelines will provide:
 - i. Information for the design, construction, operation and maintenance of facilities
 - ii. Information for retrofitting systems for water saving/conservation which is in keeping with the circular economy
 - iii. Contact information for the technical support unit and related services (e.g. technical support unit from Ministry of Health, Wellness and Elderly Affairs; sanitary engineers; masons; vacuum tankers/sewage haulers).
- 6.3 Facilitate two collaborative workshops for guidelines development for on-site and small wastewater treatment facilities and greywater management with

representatives from the water and wastewater sectors:

- This will include Government agencies, water sector organizations, NGOs, and private sector representatives (engineering firms, hotel industry, commerce and industry).

6.4 Ensures that agreed activities are completed within established timelines and manages the schedule of planned activities.

6.5 Makes recommendations and takes appropriate decisions to achieve deliverables related to a set of national guidelines for on-site and small wastewater facilities and greywater management.

6.6 Collaborates with the GEF-CReW+ focal point for project implementation and conflict management.

7.2 Design of consultation workshop to support development of wastewater guidelines for onsite and small-scale treatment facilities (**Product 2**):

- Produce workshop agenda, activities' outlines, and schedule; and prepare and print participant materials. Workshop design to include input from Government staff and the Caribbean Water and Sewerage Association Inc. (CAWASA)

7.3 Lead and conduct stakeholder consultation processes and activities related to the development of the wastewater guidelines (**Product 3**):

- Two consultation workshops for pre and post draft wastewater guidelines deliverable.
- Produce workshop reports which include a results summary after each workshop and disseminate to the GEF CREW+ Focal Point.

7.4 Produce a draft set of wastewater guidelines for onsite and small-scale treatment facilities (**Product 4**).

- Circulate draft guidelines to the GEF CREW+ Focal Point for review and comment.
- Hold consultation with agency representatives to confirm final version of draft guidelines.

7.5 Produce a final set of wastewater guidelines for onsite and small-scale treatment facilities (**Product 5**).

- Submit final guidelines to focal point for approval and acceptance

8 DELIVERABLES AND PAYMENT TIMELINE

- First payment: 10% upon delivery and approval of Product 1
- Second payment: 10% upon delivery and approval of Product 2
- Third payment: 20% upon delivery and approval of Product 3
- Fourth payment: 30% upon delivery and approval of Product 4


Please be informed that **Cabinet Conclusion No. 638 of 2022** dated September 26, 2022 approved the granting of concessions on Barrels imported at Christmas, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

1. 100% Waiver of Import Duty on personal items, food, clothing, toys and other household consumables, contained in barrels imported during the period November 01, 2022 to February 28, 2023. Electronic items are explicitly excluded;
2. The number of barrels that would qualify for the concessions would be limited to two (2) per household;
3. There would be an upper limit of EC\$2,500.00 per barrel on the value of items qualifying for the concessions;
4. The items identified in one (1) above must be for personal use only and not for commercial use; and
5. The usual penalties, fines, etc. would be applied if the goods are used for commercial purposes.

Cabinet further approved the transmission of the appropriate legal instrument to Parliament to declare barrels imported during the period November 01, 2022 to February 28, 2023 exempt from Value Added Tax (VAT).

Kindly note that items that qualify for this concession will attract Customs Service Charge at the rate of 6%.
