POST OF DIRECTOR OF INFORMATION SERVICES

RESPONSIBILITIES AND RELATIONSHIPS

1. To lead, plan, direct, manage, monitor and evaluate the gathering and dissemination of government information by formulating policies and strategies for information management; analysing, developing and implementing communication strategies; recommending, reviewing and drafting legislation; to enable the effective flow of public information to varied audiences, and to elucidate Government's plans, policies and programmes.
2. Responds to the Minister and liaises with Ministers of Government, Permanent Secretaries, Heads of Departments, local, regional and international journalists, media houses and governments and public and private sector officials and organisations and key stakeholders on matters relating to work in progress.

DUTIES AND TASKS

1. Leads and manages assigned staff through target setting, continuous dialogue, mentoring, coaching, assessment of staff performance, identifying training needs and gaps, and managing leave, to ensure effective performance management and promote employee wellbeing.
2. Plans, manages and coordinates the state's primary media and broadcasting service, social media and

World Wide Web by formulating, evaluating and implementing policies and procedures, liaising with partners and stakeholders to enable effective and relevant communication to the nation.

3. Develops policies regarding information gathering and distribution by reviewing, conceptualising and drafting of legislation in consultation with stakeholders, to enable the enactment of applicable legislation to guide the work of the media and broadcasting sector and to promote consistency and soundness of information.
4. Acts as a conduit for policy interventions between government and public sector agencies on policy statements regarding information dissemination, by attending meetings, consulting with all stakeholders, guiding the process, and providing expert advice to achieve the overall mandate of the Government.
5. Functions as the official link between the Government and media by collaborating with local, regional and international media organisations, networking and developing professional relationships so as to facilitate effective communication linkages and information sharing and distribution.
6. Assumes overall responsibility for communicating the activities of public sector agencies; critically analyses their programmes to recommend forms of publications and documentaries to feature their accomplishments, to maintain the positive image of the Government.
7. Communicates the proposed and ongoing programmes of the Government by collaborating with public sector agencies to actively communicate projects, policies, programmes, activities and events locally, regionally and internationally.

8. Monitors the local, regional and international media by paying heed to newscast, talk shows, social media, World Wide Web and local programming, to provide information and to proactively address misinformation and to offer expert guidance on public relations interventions to enable the timely management of information misrepresentation.
9. Acts as a conduit via which Government and public sector agencies can develop and design public relations strategies, produce material for electronic and print media, by dialoguing with agencies, providing expert advice and guidance to enable the creation of high quality relevant productions.
10. Monitors the programming of the National Television Network by assessing the network's programmes and working in consultation with the team to ensure that the line ups are relevant and inspiring.
11. Ensures the news segment of the Government's web portal is regularly updated by liaising with Public Sector Agencies and collaborating with stakeholders to acquire and organise information for the web portal.
12. Performs the public relations and public education function of the National Emergency Management Office (NEMO) by ensuring the dissemination of information, directly and via other mass media organisations, updating of the agency's website and providing coverage during emergencies to mitigate against the impact of disasters.
13. Develops the annual budget and coordinates the budgetary process of the Division by assessing programme initiatives to establish strategic linkages, conducting research and analyses and leading budget planning meetings, to ensure availability of funds for programme implementation, in alignment with strategic objectives.
14. Prepares submissions to the Cabinet of Ministers on matters relating to Government information dissemination through research and analysis, dialogue and consultation with line agencies and other key stakeholders, to facilitate decision making, and enable the policy development, coordination and implementation process.
15. Prepares progress reports outlining achievements and challenges in the stipulated format to keep senior management informed, for decision making, to assess the performance of the Division against established goals and for the recommendation of new policies, approaches and solutions for continuous improvement.
16. Performs any other job-related duties as may be assigned.

Saint Lucia has received financing from the World Bank towards the Caribbean Digital Transformation Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for engagement of an Individual Consultant to aid in the development of the National Broadband Strategy and Policy to provide direction and guidance for promoting widespread access to high-speed broadband services throughout Saint Lucia, as a significant driver for economic growth, job creation and poverty alleviation. The consultancy is expected to last for a period of 6 months.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include

1. Undertake an assessment of the current ICT status of Saint Lucia, using ICT Development Index (IDI), which includes, among others, indicators on fixed telephone lines, mobile subscriptions, Internet users, broadband penetration, international Internet bandwidth, and percentage of households with an electronic device.

Other relevant factors to be taken into account, such as ICT affordability (ICT Price Basket), World Summit on Information Society (WSIS) / Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) targets, economic and geographic parameters;

2. Summarize an assessment of existing policy and regulatory frameworks with a view to facilitating deployment of broadband technologies, both fixed and wireless; taking into account convergence trends;
3. Conduct a comprehensive SWOT (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats) of relevant market and sector structures and, based on this analysis, identify options for enhancing broadband development, taking into consideration local market context and international trends, legal, regulatory, financial and operational aspects.
4. Review the existing network architectures, coverage maps and identify any broadband gaps and propose potential interventions, such as investment costs, service provider taxation, and propose possible funding options, to support broadband deployment for the gaps and last mile connectivity;
5. Coordinate closely with the national consultant team working in parallel, to provide regulatory advisory services with regard to the new legislation affecting ICTs.
6. Assess key current and foreseeable economic and social determinant issues with respect to broadband demand and its uptake for broadband applications. Assess Demand estimation methodologies, which may include or combine comparative benchmarks, sustainable affordability, and adoption/attractiveness, content and services and identify policies, regulations and actions plans to stimulate supply and demand among others;
7. Coordinate with ECTEL and the NTRC to identify key policy and regulatory instruments including licensing, spectrum access/interconnection, deployment of new technologies, rollout of obligations, incentive based regulation, infrastructure sharing, universal service obligations and provide concrete recommendations to promote broadband wireless services vis-à-vis identified national priorities and international best practices;
8. In consultation with NTRC and ECTEL, define policy objectives for broadband development, strategic initiatives, key performance indicators and targets including a roadmap with established timeframes, resource requirements (with clearly defined roles and responsibilities of stakeholders), a budget and a monitoring and evaluation framework aimed at achieving affordable broadband access and improving broadband coverage with clear targets and metrics (e.g. coverage, scorecards and geographical approach);
9. Examine the opportunity for Saint Lucia to fully capitalize on the broadband and ICT era, by leveraging modern technological options and infrastructure, government support, investment incentives, competition, and highlight the potential for policy makers, regulators and other stakeholders, to foster the development and adoption of broadband in Saint Lucia;
10. Monitoring and reporting the impact of broadband on economic activity;
11. Develop a roadmap for broadband development that includes, but not limited to the following:
 - i. Provision of wi-fi to fill in access gaps for desirous individuals in all communities;
 - ii. Address Data Security and Privacy, as well as Cyber & information security / secure broadband (provider & user levels);
 - iii. Ability to track internet protocol (IP) addresses to geographic locations to assist in the prevention of cybercrime;
 - iv. Sustainability of internet exchange points (IXP); and
 - v. Recommendations on the implementation of broadband technologies in key priority sectors identified in the Digital Strategy
12. Develop instruments to seek input from stakeholders in Saint Lucia on the requisites for a national broadband strategic policy and action plan, especially regarding the current and future regulatory framework and the policy initiatives related to broadband; and
13. Conduct a national workshop aimed at informing, educating, gathering information from the stakeholders and sharing proposals.

LOBSTER FISHERY CLOSED

The Department of Fisheries, within the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food Security and Rural Development, informs that the Lobster Fishery will be CLOSED from **March 1, 2022** until **August 1, 2022**, **both days inclusive**. When the Lobster Fishery is closed, it is illegal for anyone to have lobsters in their possession.

According to Section 32 (2) (d) of the Fisheries Act Cap 7.15, of the Revised Laws of Saint Lucia, *a person shall not, fish for, remove from the fishery waters, give, or at any time have in his or her possession, expose for sale, sell, or purchase any lobster* when the lobster fishery is closed.

Members of the public, fishers, vendors and restaurant establishments who fail to comply with the requirements of the closed lobster fishery, threaten the sustainability of the lobster population. As such, **non-compliance with the lobster closed season may result in the extended closure.**

The laws protecting lobsters are key tools in ensuring that lobsters can continue to provide valuable income for local fishers, vendors and restaurateurs as well as a source of protein for the general public.

The general public, purchasers and consumers are advised that they **SHOULD NOT** purchase lobster during **March 1, 2022 to August 1, 2022** when the lobster fishery is closed. Anyone found violating the Fisheries Regulations may be fined up to **EC\$5000.00**. Reports can be made to the Marine Police at Tel #: 456-3871, the nearest Police Station or the Department of Fisheries.

CHRISTMAS BARRELS CONCESSION 2021/2022 - EXTENSION

Please be informed that **Cabinet Conclusion No.51(b) of 2022** dated January 24, 2022 approved the extension of the Christmas Barrels Concession for a period of two (2) months, from 01st February 2022 to 31st March 2022. The terms and conditions for the barrels concessions remain as follows:


1. 100% Waiver of Import Duty on personal items, food, clothing, toys and other household consumables, contained in barrels imported *between 01st February 2022 and 31st March 2022. Electronic items are explicitly excluded;*
2. The number of barrels that would qualify for the concessions would be limited to **two (2)** per household;
3. There would be an upper limit of EC\$2,500.00 per barrel on the value of items qualifying for the concessions;
4. The items identified in one (1) above must be for personal use only and not for commercial use; and
5. The usual penalties, fines, etc. would be applied if the goods are used for commercial purposes.

Cabinet further approved the transmission of the appropriate legal instrument to Parliament to declare barrels imported during the period 01st February 2022 to 31st March 2022 exempt from value added tax (VAT).

Kindly note that items that qualify for this concession will attract Customs Service Charge at the rate of 6%.

Barrels will not be delivered if these guidelines are not met.
