SAINT LUCIA has received financing from the World Bank towards the Caribbean Digital Transformation Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for engagement of an Individual Consultant to assess the current datacenter/computer room for key agencies within the Government service including a detailed inventory of existing equipment and facilities, as well as to evaluate existing infrastructure and make recommendations for consolidation or upgrade. The development of a Datacenter Strategy for the Government including the specification of a containerized Datacenter for back-up of existing sites and future projects. The consultancy is expected to last for a period of 6 months.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include

- I. Conduct detailed requirements analysis sessions with relevant stakeholders aimed at gathering and documenting key requirements to develop an integrated and appropriate future state datacenter strategy.
- II. Undertake comprehensive inventory of current data storage facilities to include:
 - a. Power (primary and back-up),
 - b. cooling,
 - c. security
 - d. connectivity
 - e. fire prevention / protection
 - f. existing computing and storage capacity
 - g. server and switching equipment
 - h. projected computing and storage capacity requirements
 - i. estimated age and service life of equipment
- III. Perform comprehensive analysis of the current data center framework and facilities environments, assessing the suitability of the existing data center facilities to meet technology architecture and infrastructure strategies.
- IV. Evaluate proposed sites for the location of the containerized datacenter to determine suitability and impact on datacenter design.
- V. Propose technical specifications for the implementation of a Containerized Data Centre for the Government of Saint Lucia including construction of suitable base and supporting infrastructure including:
 - a. Consideration for appropriate power, lighting, cooling, noise suppression, fire suppression, cable management, physical security, and additional or necessary data center infrastructure.
 - b. Consideration for servers and switching equipment to include servers, switched, sans, racks, etc.
 - c. Incorporate planned future server room and switching equipment growth of fifty (50) percent without cooling/power infrastructure retrofit or major additional data center infrastructure expense.
 - d. Be in accordance with industry standard data center definitions.
 - e. Be in accordance with current industry best practices for efficient and effective server room layout and design.
 - f. Be in accordance with current state and local building codes and best practices.
 - g. Demonstrate compliance with relevant current industry standards to provide a functional data center that is well organized, uncluttered, and easily maintainable.
 - h. Have the capability to be professionally tested and certified as part of this project.
 - i. Have a readily implementable operational manual.
- VI. Propose Government of Saint Lucia Strategy for the implementation of a Containerized Datacenter.
- VII. Create Design Blueprints and Design Documents like High Level Design (HLD), Low Level Design (LLD), Migration Procedures and Fallback Procedures etc.
- VIII. Communicate conceptual designs and maintain documentation created as a result of this consultancy.
- IX. Recommend the Human Resource requirements to successfully operationalize the Datacenter, highlighting numbers, job descriptions, skill sets including ISO certification, aptitudes and training needs;
- X. Develop a monitoring and evaluation matrix
- XI. Development of a roadmap for the implementation a Network Operation Center (NOC) at the Datacenter location.
- XII. Propose Government Datacenter Strategy to incorporate (I) through to (XI) above
- XIII. Undertake a validation exercise with all stakeholders to ensure that their needs are met by the Terms of Reference to be developed.

THE Government of Saint Lucia (GOSL) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to USD 9,153,246 towards the cost for Building Resilience for Adaptation to Climate Change and Climate Variability in Agriculture in Saint Lucia project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of GOSL and upon approval by CDB and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOSL shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food Security and Rural Development, the Executing Agency, now wishes to procure consultancy services for a Gender Assessment and Updated Environmental and Social Management Plan.

The objective of the Project is to build resilience in Saint Lucia's agriculture sector for livelihoods security through enhanced adaptive capacities for Climate Change and Climate Variability. The project design responds directly to the need to build adaptive capacities of agro-ecosystems and livelihoods given the projections of significant decreases in rainfall, more frequent and intense hydro-meteorological events, including droughts as reported in the country's Third National Communication (TNC) to the UNFCCC. The Project will contribute positively to the strategic objectives of Saint Lucia's Sectoral Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan for the Agriculture Sector (Agriculture SASAP) 2018-2028. It is also well aligned with the TNC recommendations for climate adaptation measures to enhance resilience in agriculture and with the proposals under the National Agriculture Policy Sectoral Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan (2018).

The Project is also responsive to Saint Lucia's NDCs to address food security, community and national

level interventions in water resource conservation and management. Gender equality will be mainstreamed throughout the Project to ensure gender equity is embedded in project interventions. An estimated 12,000 farmers and their families are expected to be direct beneficiaries of the Project. The duration of the assignment is expected to be for a period of four (4) months.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Consulting Firm will be under the operational and technical supervision of the Project Manager of the Project Management Unit. The Consulting Firm will carry out the following two tasks:

- a) Conduct a Gender Assessment in line with the CDB's GEPOS which is compliant with the Gender Policy of the AF
- b) Revise the Environmental and Social Management Plan (ESMP), which will be informed by the completed Gender Assessment.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

The Consulting Firm or Consortium is required to have the following:

1. A post-graduate degree in Gender studies, Sociology or related subject and professional/technical background appropriate for understanding both the environmental and social management implications of climate resilience building intervention projects in the agriculture sector.
2. A minimum of ten (10) years' experience working in the area of gender analysis and a minimum of five years' experience working on inter-linkages between gender and agricultural sector development in developing countries. Work on these issues in the Caribbean context would be an asset.
3. At least five (5) years' experience in practical safeguards, social and environmental management with demonstrated proficiency in the preparation, review, and approval of EAs/ESIAs/ESMPs to meet MDB standards.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food Security and Rural Development now invites interested eligible consulting firms to submit Expressions of Interest for the provision of these consultancy services.

Consultant Firm or Consortium shall be eligible to participate if:

- (a) in the case of a body corporate, it is legally incorporated or otherwise organized in an eligible country, has its principal place of business in an eligible country and is more than 50 per cent beneficially owned by citizen(s) and/or *bona*

fide resident(s) of eligible country(ies) or by a body(ies) corporate meeting these requirements;

- (b) in the case of unincorporated firms, the persons are citizens or *bona fide* residents of an eligible country; and
- (c) in all cases, the consultant has no arrangement and undertakes not to make any arrangements, whereby any substantial part of the net profits or other tangible benefits of the contract will accrue or be paid to a person not a citizen or *bona fide* resident of an eligible country.

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.¹ Consultants are advised to review the detailed eligibility criteria detailed in Section 4 and conflict of interest provisions in Section 5 of the Procurement Procedures for Projects Financed by CDB (January, 2021), as published on CDB's website².

In the assessment of submissions, consideration will be given to technical competence, qualifications and experience, local and regional experience on similar assignments, financial capability and existing commitments. Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.
