Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for appointment to the post of **CHIEF SURVEYOR, DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT AND URBAN RENEWAL**

RESPONSIBILITIES AND RELATIONSHIPS

1. To provide leadership and direction in planning and reviewing surveying matters; manage land acquisition programmes and projects; ensure the maintenance and security of official land registry maps; and scrutinise and analyse recorded information for maps and cadastral plans, in compliance with legislative and regulatory requirements, for the availability of official records and to achieve project goals and criteria.
2. To manage assigned staff and resources to ensure work programmes are implemented in accordance with legislative and operational requirements and established labour practices.
3. Responds to the Deputy Permanent Secretary and liaises with donor agencies, civil society organisations, non-governmental organisations, financial institutions and key stakeholders on matters relating to work-in-progress.

DUTIES AND TASKS

1. Prepares the work programme for the Section in line with the Department's strategic objectives through strategic planning, consultation with stakeholders and team members and review of key evidence-based reports/documentation, to enable the determination of targets, milestones and deadlines.
2. Leads and manages assigned staff through target setting, continuous dialogue, mentoring, coaching, assessment of staff performance, identifying training needs and gaps, and managing leave, to ensure effective performance management and promote employee wellbeing.
3. Administers Government's land acquisition programme by providing technical advice, ensuring the execution of the requisite survey, securing agreements for compensation, consulting with stakeholders, and ensuring updated and reliable data management systems for lands changed and acquired, in compliance with legislative and regulatory requirements.
4. Reviews, develops and implements procedures to facilitate the acquisition of surveying data through consultation with stakeholders, assessing existing documentation and making recommendations on findings, to expand and maintain the control survey framework.
5. Leads survey and mapping projects by undertaking site visits, consulting with stakeholders, conducting research and utilising project management methodologies, to ensure accurate drawings are produced for implementation of government projects.

6. Oversees the inventory of specialised equipment and the vehicle fleet by ensuring adherence to established procedures for storage and authorised use, and ensuring inventory checks and the maintenance of logs, to enable availability of resources and transportation, and to foster accountability.

7. Prepares submission to the Cabinet of Ministers on land acquisition matters through research and analysis, dialogue and consultation with line agencies and other key stakeholders, to facilitate decision making, and enable the policy development, coordination and implementation process.

8. Solar PV Generation**

Insertion of Definition

1. The definitions section of the Principal Notice is amended by inserting the following definition in its correct alphabetical position;

“**Special Application PV System** means an application to install a solar PV generator which exceeds the current PV system capacity limits.”

Amendment to Preamble

2. The preamble to the procedure of the Principal Notice is amended by deleting the preamble in its entirety and by substituting the following–

“A person wishing to connect a PV System (not exceeding 5kWp for residential usage, and not exceeding 25kWp for commercial usage) or a Special Application PV System to the LUCELEC grid to provide solar PV generation shall not purchase and/or install ANY equipment prior to receiving approval from the NURC.

Persons applying for NURC approval to generate electricity through a solar PV System or a Special Application PV System are hereby asked to note that by virtue of their compliance with the process hereunder, agree that upon passage of the requisite legislation to govern solar PV generation, that they will be required to comply with these legislative requirements (when passed in Parliament) and that nothing herein will be binding on the NURC or LUCELEC nor will the NURC or LUCELEC be liable for any loss or damage howsoever arising to them by virtue of this process or the change in legislation.”

Amendment to clause 1

3. The Principal Notice is amended by deleting Clause 1 and by substituting the following–

“1. A Person (hereinafter referred to as the “Applicant”) wishing to generate electricity through a solar PV system by interconnecting its system to the LUCELEC grid, shall submit to the NURC a formal application for approval (in the prescribed form) duly signed, along with payment of an application fee as follows:

- Domestic – EC\$200.00
- Commercial – EC\$500.00
- Special – EC\$2,000.00”

Insertion of clause 3A

4. The Principal Notice is amended by inserting the following–

“3A. For applications made pursuant to the Special Application PV System process, the Applicant shall include written justification for making the special application and submissions to the NURC supporting the granting of a special application in accordance with this Notice.”

Amendment to clause 7

5. The Principal Notice is amended by deleting Clause 7 and by substituting the following–

“7. Within five (5) working days of receipt by the NURC of a properly submitted application for a PV

System, a copy of the completed Application Form and all requisite documentation shall be sent to LUCELEC for consideration.”

Insertion of clause 7A

6. The Principal Notice is amended by inserting the following–

“7A. (1) Upon receiving a properly submitted application for a Special Application PV System, the NURC shall consider the application on the following relevant grounds:

- (i) National Significance
- (ii) Socio-Economic benefit

(2) Upon determination by the Commission that the Special Application PV System has met the criteria, a copy of the completed Application Form and all requisite documentation, including written justification for the approval of the application by the NURC shall be sent to LUCELEC for interconnection.”

The General Nursing Council of Saint Lucia (“the Council”) wishes to inform employers and the general public of **all practicing Nurses, Nurse Specialists, Midwives and Nursing Assistants** who are registered/licensed to practice in Saint Lucia.

Those who have not met conditions and paid the annual registration fee are in contravention of the **Registration of Nurses and Midwives Act, Chapter 11.08 (“the Act”)** and are liable to suspension. Further, the names of those who have defaulted are not published in the Gazette.

The Council therefore finds it necessary to remind **all practicing Nurses, Nurse Specialists, Midwives and Nursing Assistants** of their duty to comply with the provisions of the Act. Persons whose names do not appear in the Gazette will only be reinstated when evidence for re-registration/re-licensure is shown to Council.

The cooperation of employers and nurse managers is solicited in ensuring that **all practicing Nurses, Nurse Specialists, Midwives and Nursing Assistants** practice with the requisite certificate of registration/license.
