THE Water and Sewerage Company Incorporated (WASCO) of St. Lucia has applied for financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to US\$10.660 million towards the cost of the John Compton Dam Rehabilitation Project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of WASCO and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than WASCO shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

WASCO, the Executing Agency, now wishes to procure Consultancy Services to design the installation of approximately 5000 meters of upgraded water pipeline to replace a section of the main raw water line from the John Compton Dam/ Millet Gravity Intake Junction to Vanard Booster Station.

The objective of the Consultancy is to design an adequately sized pipeline and associated infrastructure/appurtenances to replace the existing mild steel section.
