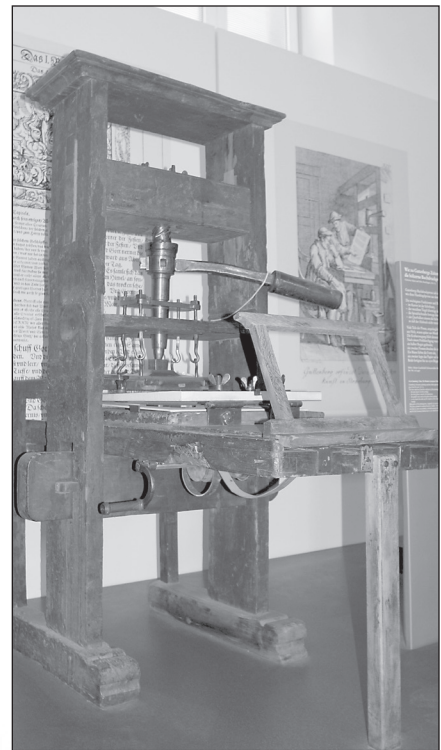
TECHNOLOGY

Technology has affected society and its surroundings in a number of ways. In many societies, technology has helped develop more advanced economies (including today's global economy) and has allowed the rise of a leisure class. However, many technological processes produce unwanted by-products, known as pollution, and deplete natural resources, to the detriment of the Earth and its environment. Various implementations of technology influence the values of a society and new technology raises new ethical questions. Examples include the rise of the notion of efficiency in terms of human productivity, a term originally applied only to machines, and the challenge of traditional norms.

Philosophical debates have arisen over the present and future use of technology in society, with disagreements over whether technology improves the human condition or worsens it. Neo-luddism and similar movements criticise the pervasiveness of technology in the modern world, claiming that it alienates people and destroys culture; proponents of ideologies such as transhumanism and techno-progressivism view contin-

ued technological progress as beneficial to society and the human condition. Indeed, until recently, it was believed that the development of technology was a concept akin and restricted only to human beings, but recent scientific studies indicate that other primates and certain dolphin communities have developed simple tools and learned to pass their knowledge to other generations.

In general, "technology" is the relationship that society has with its tools and crafts, and to what extent society can control its environment. The Merriam-Webster dictionary offers a definition of the term: "the practical application of knowledge especially in a particular area" and "a capability given by the practical application of knowledge".[1] Ursula Franklin, in her 1989 "Real World of Technology" lecture, gave another definition of the concept; it is "practice, the way we do things around here".[2] The term is often used to imply a specific field of technology; the media uses "technology" to refer to high technology, rather than technology as a whole.[3] However, the term is mostly used in three different contexts: when referring to a tool (or machine), a technique, the cultural force, or a combination of the three.



The invention of the printing press made it possible for scientists and politicians to communicate their ideas with ease, leading to the Age of Enlightenment; an example of technology as a cultural force.



Eastern Caribbean

The ECSE share index increased 2.67% last week to close at 123.53 points, as three stocks recorded upward price movements, namely SL

Horsford, up 65 cents, TDC up 50 cents and TCL up 98 cents. Bank of Nevis was the only firmly traded stock, closing the week at \$5.05.

Trinidad

The TTSE saw an increase in volumes traded as 1.5 million shares traded compared to 1.3 million the previous week. Volume leaders were NCB Jamaica, TCL and JMMB. The market indices posted mixed results as the All T & T advanced and the Composite index declined. Winners outnumbered losers 10 to 5.

Petroleum Co. of Trinidad & Tobago Ltd (Petrotrin), is about to tap the international market for US\$750 million to finance an ongoing refinery upgrade and acquisition of new equipment. Funding will be in the form of a series of amortization notes with tenure of up to 15 years. Petrotrin has already applied to have the notes listed on the Luxembourg Stock Exchange.

Jamaica

Over in Jamaica, there was a turnaround on the JSE as all three indices advanced last week. The Market index moved up 348 points, whilst the JSE Select moved 13 points and the All Jamaican Composite 705 point. 14 stocks advanced, 12 declined and 6 traded firm. Supreme Ventures & Cable & Wireless emerged volume leaders for yet another week as they both recorded increases of 39 cents and 2 cents respectively.

The National Commercial Bank Group of Jamaica has reported a 32 per cent year over year increase in its net profit for its second quarter, mainly as a result of the growth in income from the bank's non-core operations. For the quarter ending March 31st, NCB's net profit surged to \$1.6 billion, compared to the \$1.2 billion earned in the matching period for the previous year.

Barbados

In Barbados, trading activity contracted last week, though five stocks advanced and one declined resulting in positive movements for the local and composite indices while the cross list index remained unchanged. The top three traded companies were FCIB, Sagicor and Barbados Shipping & Trading.

In other news: A mere 15 months after its launch, One Caribbean Media is taking over five Caribbean FM radio stations comprising HOTT 93 in Trinidad, The Wave in St Lucia, stations in St. Kitts, Antigua & Montserrat. The company's stock is quoted on the Trinidad & Barbados stock exchanges.

Additionally, the Sagicor group reported an EPS of B\$0.51 or TT\$1.56, for the year ended December 31, 2006 - an increase of 10% from the previous year.

International

And Internationally: U.S. stocks rose for the fourth straight week, sending the Dow Jones Industrial Average above 13,000 for the first time. The S&P 500 and NASDAQ also recorded gains for the week. European stocks fell for the first time in four weeks and Asian stocks posted the first weekly drop this month.

In commodities news, Crude oil surged to the highest in almost eight months. Gold rebounded from the lowest in two weeks after the dollar touched a record low against the euro, increasing the appeal for precious metal as an alternative investment to the U.S. currency.
