In default of such acknowledgement and/or Defence the Claimant will be entitled to apply to have judgment entered against you. If the Claimant does so, you will have no right to be heard by the Court except as to costs or the method of paying any judgment unless you apply to set judgment aside.

The Public Sector ICT and e-Government unit under the Ministry of Public Service & Social Transformation is focused on improving service delivery within Government through the use of information and communication technologies. Some of the goals of the unit are to:

- coordinate in the design and development of national ICT policies and standards;

- strengthen the trust and security of Government-held information;

- coordinate in the development of an effective underlying infrastructure; and

- facilitate the development of ICT skills within Government

One initiative supported by the unit is the implementation of email services for all Government employees. In that regard all Government employees will receive an official Government of St. Lucia email address for example `firstname.lastname@gov.lc`. One of the main benefits of a standard Government of St. Lucia

email address is easy recognition of email from Government of St. Lucia employees; many employees utilize free Internet mail services such as Yahoo, Hotmail and Gmail or commercial providers such as Cable & Wireless for sending and receiving Government correspondence which may not be secure, and is open to spam or unsolicited email.

Another initiative of the unit is the improvement of the existing Government of St. Lucia web portal, which will serve as a one-stop point of access to Government information and resources for the general public. This initiative includes support for the development of websites for Government agencies that do not currently possess their own, including issuance of standard web addresses to all official Government of St. Lucia Ministries, Departments, and agencies.

In order to support these initiatives,

a Cabinet conclusion of 21st February 2008 calls for the establishment of a central Government Domain Name Registry. The Registry will be responsible for the development of requisite policies and procedures concerning management of the Government domains `gov.lc` and `edu.lc` (called second level domains). The established Government of St. Lucia Domain Name Registry, following the examples of other islands such as Barbados and Trinidad & Tobago, will facilitate internal management and administration of the Government domains `gov.lc` and `edu.lc`. Policies concerning approval of websites and email addresses utilizing these second level domains will therefore be internally established, and administered to ensure that only official Government entities or individuals are granted usage.

The anticipated date for implementation of email and web services is June 2008.



ECSE

Eastern Caribbean

It was another slow week on the ECSE as only shares of Bank of Nevis and ECFH traded, both holding firm on their last traded prices. In other news, the Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines will auction a \$16 million 91-day treasury bill on Thursday, May 22nd 2008.

Trinidad:

Volumes traded on the TTSE totaled 3.9 million units with a total value of TT\$42.6 million. National Flour Mills emerged volume leader for the period and also gained 5 cents. The advance decline ratio was 17 to 4 with National Enterprises Limited leading the advancers closing up \$2 while RBTT led decliners.

Trinidad is set to earn massive returns on sales of liquified natural gas (LNG) to the US in the latter half of this year as analysts say US LNG prices, which have already increased by 25 per cent since March, will continue to rise. The increase comes following a drop in supply as other LNG producing countries divert their exports to

more lucrative and easier-to-reach European markets.

Jamaica:

All three JSE indices posted advances with 21 of the 40 stocks traded last week closing up. Also 16 stocks declined while 3 traded firm as total volume of shares traded exceeded 44 Million units valued at over J\$464 Million. Cable and Wireless Jamaica Ltd. was the volume leader followed by Desnoes and & Geddes Ltd. and NCB Jamaica Ltd.

FCIB Jamaica has reported another year of solid performance with growth in total revenues of 22 per cent or J\$3.28 billion. The Managing Director said that in response to deteriorating market conditions the Bank focused on the high growth sectors of the economy and on containing costs. Consequently through strategies employed the Bank saw a 32 per cent growth in net income before tax which exceeded the J\$1 billion mark for the first time.

Barbados:

Barbadian indices were up last week as the Regular Market traded a total volume topping 240,000 shares. The top three traded companies were Sagicor, FCIB and Banks

Holdings Limited. Of the three, Sagicor was the only advancer, closing up 17 cents while FCIB held firm and Banks closed down 30 cents.

An executive member of the Barbados Bankers' Association, said the profit margins in Barbados were among the lowest when compared with Trinidad and Tobago and the Eastern Caribbean. He was responding to concerns expressed by the Central Bank governor that commercial banks in Barbados were not lowering lending rates to a point that reflected the reductions the Central Bank mandated for interest rates paid on savings accounts.

International:

Internationally, most U.S. stocks declined, led by retailers and financial companies, after consumer confidence slumped to the lowest in 28 years.

The depressed consumer confidence also caused the dollar to fall the most against the euro in a month and depreciated versus the yen.

And finally, crude oil rose above \$127 a barrel for the first time, on speculation Chinese diesel purchases will strain supplies.

SPORTS

CRICKET

Sidebottom double levies momentum

England's pack leader, Ryan Sidebottom, took two wickets in as many overs to steal back the momentum from New Zealand on an intriguing first session at Old Trafford. With lunch approaching, Jamie How and Aaron Redmond had dominated the morning with a fine opening stand, until an error in judgement from Redmond gave England the breakthrough and Sidebottom further capitalised with the second wicket of James Marshall. At lunch, it was an even contest though it was England who skipped into the interval with newly found confidence.

It was all New Zealand for three-quarters of the morning, however, and England's bowlers were made to toil, How and Redmond providing rare ballast to New Zealand's fragile to-order with a fine opening stand of 80. All the talk of the Old Trafford pitch being fast and bouncy - and New Zealand's struggles to play the short ball - amounted to little, and it was only Redmond's loss in concentration 20 minutes before lunch which gave England a sniff.

How and Redmond's opening stand was New Zealand's first of fifty or more since How and Craig Cumming in 2006, and their highest since Stephen Fleming and Mark Richardson put on 163 at Trent Bridge four years ago. Fourteen opening pairs have been tried in just four years, and although there was little evidence of Redmond's stickability at Lord's, there was plenty this morning. Perhaps the most telling aspect of the session was the pair's dismissive attitude of Monty Panesar - who has taken 18 cheap wickets in two Tests prior to today - and the aggressive nature of their strokeplay which yielded 61 from the first hour. Panesar was nullified and muted.

The momentum was with New Zealand almost from the outset. Sidebottom gave little away, as ever, but James Anderson was predictably unpredictable. New Zealand took him for 23 from a poor five-over spell, capitalising on anything that drifted down the leg-side with How flicking him powerfully through midwicket to get off the mark. Redmond was initially less assured - Anderson hurrying him when he eventually found his length - but the squirts and edges invariably fell short of the slips, or flew through them, to get New Zealand off to a flying start.

How looked in excellent touch, dispatching Anderson for four straight down the ground and flaying Sidebottom over the slips with aggressive intent. Tellingly, after a mere 37 minutes of the

Test, Monty Panesar - Michael Vaughan's trump card - was introduced, but in spite of his excellent record at the ground, not even he could stem the flow of runs, in spite of gaining quite a bit of turn. This, though, was due in part to a clear policy of attack from both batsmen, Remond lifting him over the top for a brutal four before How swept him over midwicket, nearly for six. New Zealand weren't just staving off England's attack: they were dominating, and How brought up his third fifty from 75 balls with a calm tuck off his hip.

After Stuart Broad had produced a tidy, if ineffective, spell, Sidebottom was back into the attack. Always thinking, forever plotting, he brought himself around the wicket and found several deliveries to move away from Redmond. But, in a brilliant set-up, he moved one back into the right-hander who fatally shouldered arms, the ball clipping his off bail. England weren't done yet: in Sidebottom's next over, again around the wicket, he straightened one from wide of the crease into Marshall's pads, and England had their second to levy the balance.

Panesar might have been taken for 26 from six overs, yet the amount of turn he gained was notable, and Daniel Vettori could be seen huddled over a monitor in the dressing room no doubt planning his revenge tomorrow. New Zealand will be disappointed to lose two late wickets, but a platform has been laid and England have a fight on their hands.

FOOTBALL

Ronaldo: Future will be sorted soon

Cristiano Ronaldo insists his Manchester United future will be settled next week, with Real Madrid reportedly lining up a £100million bid.

Portugal winger Ronaldo starred for United in the 2007/08 season as he netted 42 goals in all competitions to help the club to a Premier League and Champions League Double. That form has stoked rumours that Real are set to test United's resolve over the summer with a record-breaking £100million bid.

However, Ronaldo - who scored United's goal in their 1-1 Champions League final draw with Chelsea before seeing his spot-kick

saved by Petr Cech in the Red Devils' shoot-out success - has dropped the strongest hint yet that he is set to agree a new deal at Old Trafford.

"My future will be clear next week. Everyone will be pleased - my club as well as me," Ronaldo - who joined United in 2003 in a £12million move from Sporting - said in The Sun.

"I think I will definitely be here next season. Yes, I want to stay. I have played five years for this club and I'd love to stay here.

"I love the people, the players are fantastic, the atmosphere is unbelievable, the staff are great. That is the reason I want to stay.

"We won the most important trophies this season. I want to do it again next season but no one knows the future.

"I want to stay, I feel very happy in the club. I win trophies, the people are friendly, supporters are amazing, everything is fun for me. It's very good."

Ronaldo also insists he now feels comfortable after coming in for criticism for his part in Wayne Rooney's sending off in Portugal's 2006 World Cup quarter-final victory over England.

"After the last two years I feel the English people have been friendly to me. I enjoy playing in England but no one knows the future," he continued.

And Ronaldo believes he, and United, can only get better next season as they bid to defend their domestic and European crowns. "This is a young team and we have everything to win next year," added Ronaldo. "We want to win the Champions League again and we have a good chance. We have a good team spirit.

"I can get better. The goals are not the most important thing. Maybe I will play well next year but I won't score as many goals.

"But I'm going to try to do my best. Every season I've improved and I want to improve next year."
