Hurricane Tomas Slope Stabilization Project

Invitation for Geotechnical Investigation

THE Ministry of Communications, Works, Transport and Public Utilities of the Government of St. Lucia invites contractors to carry out Geotechnical Investigations for Slope Stabilization Work in respect of various sites as part of the Hurricane Tomas Rehabilitation Works.

The project aims to restore the integrity of various sites affected due to the effects of Hurricane Tomas. These works will ensure the population's access to markets and social services in all weather conditions.

It is envisaged that the ground investigations shall include the following:

Boring and coring of 5 to 7 boreholes at each site (to be confirmed as the investigations proceed)

In situ testing and sampling

Installation of standpipe piezometers with slip indicator mandrels

Laboratory testing

Detailed logging of all boreholes by an experienced engineering geologist or geotechnical engineer

Cable percussion borehole investigation to 10 metres depth (2 No Shell & Auger)

Rotary borehole drilling extending 1 Shell & Auger borehole to 15 metres depth (1 No Rotary Coring);

Surveying of exploratory hole positions;

In-situ testing of soil and groundwater;

Laboratory testing of soil and rock;

The retention of groundwater, soil and rock samples

Preparation and presentation of detailed factual reports and drawings as per the Specification and the Scope of Works;

Liaison with MCWT&PU, landowners and the other public and private bodies as necessary;

The Bill of Quantities shall provide details on the requirements of each site.

The project is expected to run from the October to December quarter of 2011 and is expected to be completed within the same period.

The implementing agency is the Ministry of Communications, Works, Transport and Public Utilities (MCWT & PU).

The full scope of the works is outlined in more detail in the tender documents.. Access to borehole positions within the landslides will be the responsibility of the GI contractor.
