## Open Sea Turtle Fishery

THE Department of Fisheries informs the public that the Sea Turtle Fishery will be open from October 1st 2013 to December 31st, 2013, both days inclusive. As stipulated under the Fisheries Act and Regulations Cap. 7:15 of the revised laws of St. Lucia 2008:

No person shall:

Disturb, remove from the fishery waters, expose for sale, sell, purchase, or at any time have in his/her possession any turtle eggs;

Interfere with any turtle nest, or turtle that is nesting;

Remove from the fishery waters, expose for sale, sell purchase or at any time have in his possession any undersized turtle;

Set within 100 meters of the shores of Saint Lucia any net or seine or any other artifice for the purpose of or with the intention of fishing for, catching or taking any turtle.

In this Regulation-

"turtle" includes the whole or any part of any turtle;

Undersized means a weight less than:

27.22 kilograms (60lbs) for Hawksbill (Erectmochelys imbricate);

34.02 kilograms (75lbs) for Green (Chelonia mydas) and Loggerhead (Caretta caretta)

It therefore means that only a Hawksbill Turtle weighing 60lbs or more and Green or Loggerhead Turtle weighing 75lbs or more are permitted to be fished. The capture of the Leatherback Turtle is prohibited.

The Department appeals to the general public and fishers to report to the Marine Police, the nearest Police Station or the Department of Fisheries, any fisher or person that is not complying with the rules of the open fishery. Anyone caught violating the terms of the Sea Turtle fishery may be fined up to EC\$5000.00 for each offence.

### Conditions for the 2013 Sea Turtle Fishery

THE Ministry of Agriculture, Food Production, Fisheries and Rural Development, wishes to inform that the Sea Turtle Fishery will only be open from Tuesday October 1st to December 31st, 2013 both days inclusive.

For harvesting of this resource, all fishers and the public are required to adhere to the following conditions:

#### WHO

Only traditional sea turtle fishers are authorised to take part in the sea turtle fishery.

#### WHEN

The Sea Turtle Fishery shall extend from October 1st to December 31st, 2013. No person shall fish for, remove from the fishery waters, or at any time have in his possession, expose for sale, sell or purchase any sea turtle from January 1st, 2014.

#### WHAT

Leatherback (UToti anklen"; "Agalou") sea turtle are NOT TO BE CAPTURED. All leatherback sea turtles that are caught must be released.

Only the Green (UToti"), Hawksbill (UKawet"), and loggerhead (UKawen") sea turtle are permitted to be captured.

Only turtles that meet the legal size according to the Fisheries Act Cap. 7:15 shall be targeted. That is; Green and Loggerhead must weigh 75 lbs or more; the hawksbill must weigh 60lbs or more.

No person shall interfere with any sea turtle nest or nesting sea turtle.

No person shall at any time, disturb, remove from the fishery waters, expose for sale, sell, purchase at any time or have in his possession any sea turtle eggs.

#### HOW

The only gear allowed for capturing sea turtle is a turtle net. Nets must not be set and left over night. Nets can only be set for 4 hours and are to be operated in such a way that sub legal turtles ( i.e less than the legal size) can be released alive.

No spearing or harpooning of sea turtles is permitted

There shall be no fishing of sea turtles within 100 metres ( 300 feet) of the shore.

There shall be no fishing for sea turtles on or above coral reef areas Sea turtles must be landed whole and taken to a designated landing site, where sea turtle data shall be collected by the data collector or fisheries officer.

No sea turtle shall be slaughtered or sold on beaches or in other open places.

Only designated landing sites and fish markets shall be used

No products(meat, shell, jewellery, souvenirs, etc) are to be made from the turtle shell or their products for local sale or export.

No sea turtle meat is to be sold at any restaurant or tourism establishment that caters primarily to tourist/non nationals.

Each contravention of the above Conditions shall result in a maximum fine of five thousand dollars (EC\$5000)as stipulated under the Fisheries Act and Regulation Cap. 7:15.

The Department of Fisheries will be conducting monitoring activities islandwide to obtain any information on sea turtles captured during the period and will working along with the Police, Customs and other enforcement agencies to ensure that all persons abide by the harvest conditions stipulated above.

All harvesting activities must cease after the last day of the open period. No person shall be allowed to have in their possession or expose for sale any sea turtle meat or shell after the closure of the harvest period. Fishers and the general public are hereby urged to observe and comply with the aforementioned conditions.
