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POST OF BIOMEDICAL ENGINEER III, II, I

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Functions as primary contact responsible for the Biomedical Engineering Department and provides support by ensuring appropriate maintenance of medical equipment and training of staff in the proper use, application and operational performance of patient care equipment.

Provides leadership for all components of medical equipment management.

DUTIES AND TASKS:

Advises hospital administrators on the planning, acquisition, and use of medical equipment.

Evaluates the safety, efficiency, and effectiveness of biomedical equipment

Installs, adjusts, maintains, and/ or repairs biomedical equipment.

Supervises the work of the Biomedical and Electronic Technicians.

Evaluates staff productivity, quality and work efficiency.

Ensures that all resources are available to staff members as needed to allow them to perform maintenance and repair of medical equipment and systems as assigned.

Recommends equipment renovation, refurbishment or replacement based on equipment age, failure rate, cost of service and overall ability to support the clinical use for which it is intended.

Collaborates with other support units (e.g Facilities Management or Information Technology) to develop support plans for devices or systems that require multi-disciplinary support.

Maintains and catalogues inventory of equipment.

Designs and follows a preventive maintenance programme for equipment at the hospital.

Prioritizes and schedules work according to priorities established.

Organizes department for maximum utilization of available staff.

Implements work order systems.

Communicates effectively with the Hospital Engineer.

Deals with technical queries from the hospital.

Provides training to Biomedical Technicians as necessary.

Functions as a resource person to area of responsibility. This includes providing instructions as to the safe and proper use of equipment or acting as technical support to assign staff as well as other technical or clinical staff.

Liaises closely with other medical professionals such as doctors and other end users.

Keeping up to date with new developments at home and abroad.

Develops and plans the operational budget for the Biomedical Department.

May be required to perform complex repairs involving extensive troubleshooting to the component level.

CONDITIONS:

Institutional support is provided through appropriate Civil Service Regulations and Hospital policies and procedures.

Salary is in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated by the Government in the Estimates/Collective Agreement.

POST OF RADIOGRAPHER II RELATIONSHIPS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Works under the direction of, and reports to the Senior Radiographer

Expected to work with fellow Radiographers, Radiologists, and requesting Medical Doctors

Required to co-operate with departmental and hospital team in ensuring high quality Radiologic Services.

DUTIES AND TASKS:

Performs standard radiographic procedures (examinations), requested by a qualified Medical Doctor.

Carries out diagnostic radiographic procedures with appropriate patient handling and produces radiographs of optimum quality.

Ensures radiation protection for all patients and persons within the department, fully respecting the ALARA PRINCIPLES and CODE of PRACTICE for the safe use of Ionizing Radiation in Medicine.

Assists the radiologist with special radiological procedures, that is, where a contrast agent and Fluoroscopy is used.

Ensures proper use and care of the equipment in Radiology Department.

Reports any equipment failure or damage to the Senior Radiographer.

Reports and records any accidents and/or injuries sustained by a patient, during the performance of pertinent Radiographic studies to the Senior Radiographer.

Complies with the Code of Conduct/Ethics for Radiographers/ Medical Imaging Technologists.

Shares the responsibilities of any emergency on-call service in place, exceptions being given by the Senior Radiographer where appropriate.

Instructs and practically guides the Assistant Radiographer in correct radiographic practices

CONDITIONS:

Accommodation provided in Department's general administrative office.

Institutional support is provided through appropriate Civil Service Regulations and Departmental guidelines

The officer must avail himself/ herself to personal development and career advancement opportunities.

Salary is in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated by Government in the Estimates / Collective Agreement.

Functions in a traveling post and is entitled to travelling and mileage allowances, requiring the officer

to maintain a motor vehicle for the effective performance of duties.

EVALUATION METHODS OR STANDARDS:

Work performance will be evaluated on the basis of the following: -

Level of competence in effectively carrying out all radiographic responsibilities with appropriate patient handling while maintaining privacy, modesty and human dignity.

Evidence of radiation protection by strict beam collimation, use of best exposure technique factors, gonad shields, and recorded information on questioning of female patients of reproductive capacity.

The level of efficiency in assisting the radiologist with fluoroscopic procedures by promptly changing cassettes, setting exposure factors and finally retrieving processed radiographs to establish completion of procedures.

All imaging equipment must be used in accordance with manufacturers' recommendation based on established Radiological techniques. Overall cleanliness must be maintained to ensure the integrity of moving parts of the machines and also for compliance with hygienic standards of the hospital.

The promptness, accuracy and level of responsibility with which any suspected or established equipment failure/ damage is reported to superiors and the acuity with which any such problem was established.

The promptness, accuracy and level of responsibility with which any accident/ injury sustained by patients during the performance of pertinent radiological study. The expedience and urgency given to the management of the injured patient is also utilized as a yardstick to measure efficiency.

Shows continued interest in personal self-development, e.g. continuing education, to further the advancement of the service that is provided.

The level of compliance with all regulations established in the Code of Conduct and Ethics for Medical Imaging Technologists.

The availability, willingness and level of responsibility and efficiency in the performance of on call/call out duties after normal working hours, response time both by telephone to establish initial contact and then to actually be physically on site to perform duties.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A Bachelor's degree in Medical Diagnostic Radiography or related field with no previous civil service experience

Or

A Diploma in Medical Diagnostic Radiography from an accredited university (a minimum of three (3) years duration in the program) with three (3) years post qualifying experience or experience at a post of Grade 7 and above.



OPEN SEA TURTLES FISHERY

THE Ministry of Agriculture, Food Production, Fisheries, Cooperatives & Rural Development wishes to inform the general public that the **Sea Turtle Fishery** will be

open from Wednesday October 1 to December 31 2014 both days inclusive.

The Department of Fisheries will conduct monitoring activities island wide to obtain information on sea turtle captured during the period and will be working along with the Police and other enforcement agencies to ensure that the conditions are adhered to.

In addition all harvesting activities must cease after the last day of the open period. No person shall be allowed to have in their possession or expose for sale any sea turtle meat or shell after the closure on January 1st 2015. Fishers and the general public arre hereby urged to observe and comply with all regulations.

Further, the Department seeks the cooperation of the public to report to the marine police, district police stations or Fisheries Department anyone or establishment found contravening the regulations. Failure to comply shall result in a maximum fine of up to five thousand dollars (EC\$5000) for each offence.
